Merry Christmas!

A special **welcome** to those who may be visiting us today.

As Christmas continues, today we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph. What

made the Holy Family holy? The fact that it was centered on Christ. What can make our families holy? Centering them on Christ. How do we do this? Our Scripture readings today provide a few good ways: (1) honoring and caring for one another (Sir 3:2-6, 12-14), (2) loving and forgiving one another (Col 3:12-17), and (3) obeying the precepts of the Lord (Lk 2:22-40). This is what Christ came to do for us. This is what Jesus, Mary, and Joseph did for one another as they embraced their role in the Father's plan of salvation. This is what the Lord calls us to do to place him at the center of our families, our Church, and our world so as to make them holy. Let's pray for the graces we need during this Christmas season to do it!

This Monday we celebrate the **Solemnity of the Blessed Virgin Mary, the Mother of God.** It is a holyday, but not one of obligation this year. Nevertheless, let us start the new year off right,

namely, by gathering to celebrate the Eucharist and place ourselves under the patronage and protection of the Blessed Mother.

This Friday and Saturday we observe the **first Friday and Saturday** of the month. Both of our parishes have wonderful opportunities to grow in the spiritual life. On first Fridays at Sacred Heart we have the Rosary (7:40 AM), Mass (8:00 AM), First Friday Devotional Prayers (8:30 AM) Confessions and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament (8:45 – 9:30 AM). On first Saturdays at Divine Mercy we have Confessions and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament (7:45 – 8:45 AM), the Rosary (8:30 AM), Mass (9:00 AM), First Saturday Devotional Prayers (9:30 AM). Come, pray with us and obtain the special graces and blessings that these devotions bring.
