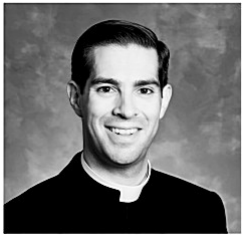

Greetings in the Lord!

Job's sentiments in our first reading today are heavy: "Is not...life on earth a drudgery?...I shall not see happiness again" (Jb 7:1-4, 6-7). Saint Paul's sentiments in our second reading are also somewhat heavy: "I preach the gospel...for an obligation has been imposed on me" (1 Cor 9:16-19, 22-23).
