



#### Crisis of Faith:

- 50% of young Americans who were raised Catholic no longer call themselves Catholic.
- The other 50% do not all attend Mass or have a personal dynamic faith.
- For every person who becomes Catholic, 6.5 leave.

  - Unaffiliated (49%), Evangelical (25%), Mainline Protestant (13%) Other (13%)
