

Pastor's Corner

Dear Beloved Parishioners,

The Church in her wisdom has designated May as the month of Mary. The whole month of May calls us to ponder God's gift of Mary to us. Many years ago, I was asked by a couple to celebrate a funeral mass for their son. The husband was Catholic, but the wife was agnostic. The husband was the stepfather. His relationship with his stepson was quite different than his wife's. It seemed as though he was not very close to him. I spent some time reflecting upon what to say. What do I say to a mother who has no faith? How do I console a mother who is inconsolable?

The uniqueness and sacredness of motherhood came to mind. In my homily, I mentioned that sometimes only a mother's love is unconditional. That sometimes only a mother sees the good in her children when others do not. That sometimes only a mother sees the potential in her children when others do not. That sometimes only a mother forgives her children readily when others do not. That was how she was with her son.

That is how the Blessed Virgin Mary is with us as well, but all the more. With his last breath as he hung high on the cross, Jesus, out of love for us, gave his mother Mary to us to be our mother. Mary sees us as her beloved sons and daughters. Mary loves us with the same love she had for her son. Mary loves us always. Mary comforts our inconsolable grief and mourning always. For she too lost her son to a horrific death. Mary is there for us always. Flee to Mary always for she awaits to tenderly and lovingly wrap her hands and arms around us. More importantly, she comes in haste to us in our time of need. May we open the door of our hearts to Mary our mother always.

Prayers at the Presentation of the Gifts

The prayers at this time of preparation in the Mass focus on the praise of God. The priest raises the gift of bread a little above the altar and prays a prayer based on the Jewish table prayer said by the father of a family before the meal, a prayer that blesses and praises God for creation and the gift of bread. Following this ritual the prayer over the wine takes place in similar fashion.

In these prayers God is praised for the works of creation. Bread and wine are the Godgiven fruits of the earth touched by human hands and they symbolize our world, our life, and our labor. It is these simple gifts that become our bread of life and our spiritual drink, a precious gift which we have the privilege of sharing with one another.
