

### What We Believe

**Dear Beloved Parishioners**,

On this Pentecost Sunday, it would be appropriate to wish all of you a very Happy Birthday. The Solemnity of Pentecost is considered the birth of the Church. The Church was born into the world by the power and presence of the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit that conceived Jesus in Mary's womb conceives the Church by coming upon the disciples of Jesus as tongues of fire. What a powerful image that is, indeed.

Fire is unique. Fire consumes everything it touches. It transforms everything into something completely different. A thing, a person is changed forever on an ontological level. Filled and on fire with the Holy Spirit, the disciples are no longer disciples. They become Apostles, one who is charged and commissioned by Jesus himself to go forth into the whole world to preach the Good News. Whenever the Word of God is proclaimed, it is as if the Church, the faith is born once again.

#### THE CHURCH IS THE PEOPLE OF GOD

About 10 years ago, I had the opportunity to go to The Vatican with a group of parishioners and our pastor. In St. Peter's Basilica, there are many smaller side altars where groups can celebrate Mass. Our group celebrated at the altar in which the body of St. John XXIII is laid to rest, behind a glass panel.

Father thought it would be a great idea to have me offer the reflection during the Mass. I was so nervous! I wanted to say something so profound, memorable and challenging. But I was a little intimidated by my surroundings, including the security guards who stood in the back listening to every word I said!

St. John XXIII, of course, opened the Second Vatican Council. So I thought I would reflect on one of the main ideas that came out of the Council. The one idea that was repeated over and over was that the Church is the People of God. We are the Church. All of us! From the Pope to the youngest child, we are the Church.

On this feast of Pentecost, the birthday of the Church, we are asked once again to BE the Church. We are asked to take on the mission Jesus gave to his first disciples: to spread the Good News that God loves us and forgives us, to the ends of the earth, or at least spread it in the world around us, at work or school or at home, or anywhere else we happen to be. And of course, we have all the gifts of the Holy Spirit to help us do just that. The gifts of courage, wisdom, knowledge, understanding, right judgement, reverence and awe and wonder are ours to use every day.


