#### **Summer Thoughts**

This year the month of July is one of retreat time for me. I am spending three weeks at three different retreats with the Sisters and Associates of Notre Dame de Namur in Carmel. As I write this, I have just completed the first retreat entitled "Moving in Grace." This retreat focused on the various forms of prayer. As I entered into this time of faith-sharing and introspection, I want you to know that I brought our parish community along with me with my intention to rest and refresh, in the hopes that this summer offers all of us a chance to ponder our journeys in the bounty of nature and the beautiful weather we share.

In this week's Gospel reading, in the longer version, Jesus gives us the parable of the mustard seed, the small seed that grows into the large plant, a metaphor for faith. Jesus uses what is familiar to his audience to illustrate his message. Taking a deeper look at our own everyday surroundings is equally revelatory. God is constantly revealing who God is and inviting us to notice. With that in mind, I would like to share a poignant poem entitled "Praying," from poetess Mary Oliver's, *Thirst*:

It doesn't have to be

the blue iris, it could be
weeds in a vacant lot, or a few
small stones; just
pay attention, then patch
a few words together and don't try
to make them elaborate, this isn't
a contest but the doorway
into thanks, and a silence in which
another voice may speak.


