

Pastor's Corner

We Believe

Dear Beloved Parishioners,

The role of woman has always held a prominent position throughout The Old and The New Testament. In the first Creation story, it is written God created male and female. In the second Creation story, woman is made from one of Adam's ribs. These two Creation stories reveal the absolute truth that woman is equal to man and is his co-partner in life. Through woman, the Blessed Virgin Mary, Jesus was conceived and born into the world. Woman, Mary Magdalene, is the first person to see, encounter and experience the risen Lord himself.

In today's first reading from the Book of Proverb, the very Word of God proclaims that woman, a worthy wife's value is far beyond pearls and is an unfailing prize to man. Do we not hear stories of man seeking and finding buried treasure in the ground or in the sea. When he does find it, he is rich beyond imagination. Our faith reminds us that the value of woman far exceeds all the cumulative treasures in the world. For God himself created woman. Man created rusted and tarnished treasure that has no intrinsic value. Only human beings are priceless and woman more.

Whenever a couple comes to me for marriage preparation, I always say to them that my hope and prayer for them is that they always see each other as a tremendous gift and blessing from God. In the same breath, I tell the man to have the mindset of believing that he is not worthy enough to have his fiancée. With this in mind, he will always treat his wife with respect, dignity and love, as well as cherish her in his heart forever. If all men did this would not the world be quite something.
