October 19 is the Feast of the North American Martyrs. We have a reliquary in the Narthex at Holy Martyrs Church in their honor. The eight Jesuits--Jean de Brébeuf, Noël Chabanel, Antoine Daniel, Charles Garnier, René Goupil, Isaac Jogues, Jean de Lalande and Gabriel Lalemant--are some of the most heroic and noble men in the church's calendar of saints. They worked in the wilderness, among people with whom they had little in common other than their common humanity, far from their homelands, sometimes together,

sometimes apart, always bound to the Lord, in "New France," in the 17th century. Their work defies imagination even today. After 14 years as a missionary, Jean de Brébeuf died on March 16, 1639. He was 56. At his death his heart was eaten as a way for the Iroquois, who were stunned by his courage, to share in his bravery. Eight other Jesuits were martyred around this same time, and are now referred to as the North American Martyrs.

God is the author of the Sacred Scriptures. He inspired the human authors, through their own language, style, and powers, to consign to writing whatever he wanted written, and no more. Because God is the author, the Scriptures always teach the truth. All Scripture tells a single story—the story of salvation that culminates in Jesus. The Old Testament prepares for the New, and the New Testament fulfills the Old.






