KNOWING THE FAITH

Week 4: The Story of Salvation

The key words we will focus on from the videos this week are STORY and GOSPÉL. What is the story of the Gospel? Do we know that this story is

God, who is infinitely perfect and happy in himself, freely created man to make him share his own goodness and love (cf. CCC, no. 1). This union with God brought harmony to the human family.

When man and woman disobeyed God and refused to give themselves in love, this sin broke our relationship with God, broke the harmony between man and woman, brought death into the world, and wounded our human nature leaving us with the inclination to sin.

Father, and He sends the Holy Spirit to fill us with his very life.
Jesus established the universal "Catholic" Church to gather the broken family of man into the united family of God. The Catholic Church passes on the teachings of Christ and, through the sacraments, dispenses the graces he won for us on the Cross to enable us to live like him on earth and with him forever in Heaven.




