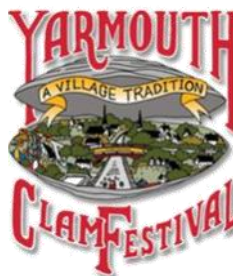

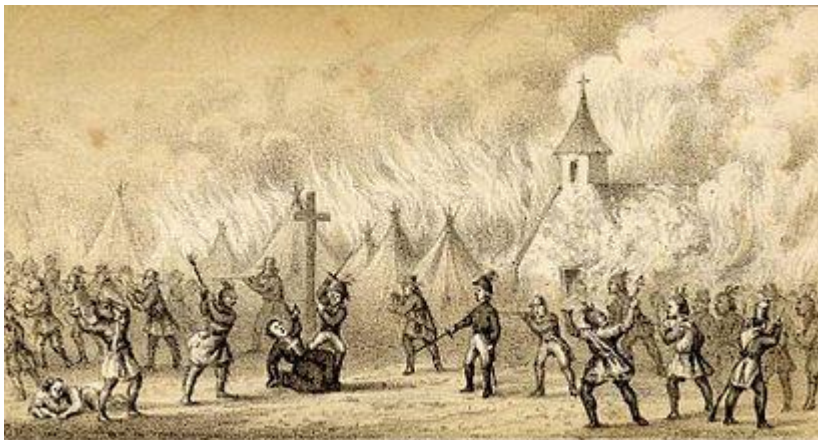

A Maine Martyr:

A Talk On the Life and Death of Fr. Sebastian Rale

In 1717, a Maine priest was given an ultimatum: leave Norridgewock, Maine and the Abenaki people or face the consequences. He refused. In 1724, Fr. Sebastian Rale was shot and scalped by a New England militia. Come hear seminarian Joe Moreshead tell the story of a pastor who refused to abandon his flock.

POTHE thanks Catherine Gallerizzo for her service over the last year and wishes her success at her new position as the Coordinator of Youth & College Ministry at Good Shepherd Parish in Saco and the University of New England in Biddeford.

Boy Scout Camden Rollins has selected to improve Sacred Heart Prayer Garden behind the church. This project will allow Camden to complete his Eagle Scout Rank requirement of providing Community Service, encompassing more than 400 hours of coordination, planning, and construction.

This project has been in progress since December 2017, and will be completed in Summer 2018. Improvements to the Prayer Garden include construction of a wood pergola (10' x 12'), a crushed stone sitting area, granite benches, granite stone border, shrubs flowers, and wood bark chip.

Donations of any amount are appreciated to support this project. A plaque will be placed on a mounting stone (similar to the Prayer Garden design) in memory of for those who donate \$100.00 or more. Additionally, you can donate money to help purchase any of these items: granite bench (\$350), shrubs (\$400), granite stones (\$100), crushed stone (\$300) and landscaping bark chips (\$200).
