Haiti Update

For this mid-summer weekend, our Parish highlights the special relationship we have with a sister parish in Haiti - Sacre-Coeur de Meyer. We reaffirm our support with prayer, messages,

and financial help. We ask that you make a donation at the door collection at the end of Mass.

The commitment by Parish of the Holy Eucharist to the church in Haiti has three features:

- Regular support for the Meyer church and the Pastor Pere Bertrand Dieuveille.
- Assistance to the Parish Community Center of Cyvadier/Meyer where four religious Sisters conduct training in nutrition and health, as well as religious instruction for children and direct support to local families. The Sisters are members of the Congregation of Our Lady of Perpetual Help (Motherhouse in St. Damien, Quebec).
- Support is given to a rural parish in Marbial for a feeding program for school children, under the guidance of Pere Phanel Chery.

Our Parish has maintained a long-standing link to the Haitian church, starting in 1990 with Sacred Heart and later expanding to include the four churches of Parish of the Holy Eucharist. Our commitment has continued in the hope that we can provide an element of stability to help in a place which has serious, ongoing challenges. In recent weeks in Haiti there have been riots when the government raised fuel taxes (later rescinded), followed by the resignation of the Prime Minister/Cabinet, and now the country is facing the Caribbean hurricane season.

We continue to sing... I ask for Haiti.

I call her by name... I present her to the Father in Jesus' name.

The Parish is also busy with church programs to strengthen spiritual life of the community. They


include the following -

Seminarian Joseph Moreshead to lead Fr. Rale Pilgrimage on August 11 In visiting the places he preached and ministered, those gathered at a special pilgrimage in Madison on Saturday, August 11, will have the opportunity to experience a walk in the historic footsteps of Fr. Sebastian Râle. All are welcome to attend.

There will be several opportunities for prayer and meditation during the pilgrimage, and excerpts from letters written by or about Father Râle will be read along with Scripture passages. The pilgrimage will conclude around 1 pm at the memorial of Father Râle, located in St. Sebastian Cemetery on the spot where he was killed.

"I think that realizing that it happened here and that these are people are not so far removed from us, people can realize that this is our call as well," said Moreshead, "to go set the world on fire with Christ's love just like Father Râle did."
