Fr. Rale Pilgrimage 2018



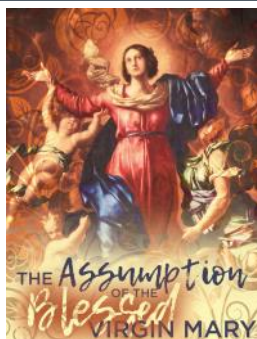

Those gathered at this special pilgrimage in Madison on Saturday, August 11, will have the opportunity to experience a walk in the historic footsteps of Fr. Sebastian R  le. All are welcome to attend.

A bus will depart from Holy Martyrs in Falmouth at 7:00 am and return at 3:00 pm. There is no charge for attending. Light snacks will be provided but you are encouraged to pack a lunch. You may also meet us at 9:00 am at Notre Dame Church, 273 Water Street in Skowhegan.

There will be several opportunities for prayer and meditation during the pilgrimage, and excerpts from letters written by or about Father R  le will be read along with Scripture passages.

The pilgrimage will conclude with a procession at the site of the old mission at Old Pointe in Madison, Maine. The procession is roughly a half mile; for those unable to do the walk please bring a lawn chair since prayers will be recited simultaneously at the Fr. Rale Monument.
