Our liturgical season's color is **PURPLE**.

WHAT KIND OF PROPHET AM I?

Scripture Background: A prophet is someone whom God chooses to speak truths from God. The Prophet of the Most High, John the Baptist, echoes the words of the Old Testament prophet, Isaiah, by announcing God's truth that someone very powerful is coming, someone we do not want to miss, someone who will purify and save us, Jesus. As Isaiah told the Jewish captives in his own time, John tells us to prepare our hearts to be free and faithful as we follow a way which God has prepared for us.

WE READ THE GOSPEL: Luke 3:3-6

John went throughout the whole region of the Jordan, proclaiming a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins, as it is written in the book of the words of the prophet Isaiah: A voice of one crying out in the desert, **"Prepare the way of the Lord, make straight his paths. Every valley shall be filled and every mountain and hill shall be made low. The winding roads shall be made straight, and the rough ways made smooth, and all flesh shall see the salvation of God."**

WE PRAY: "Lord Jesus, open our eyes, our ears, our hearts and minds, to call your name and to receive your guidance, your peace, and your love. We ask the holy saints and angels to pray for and with us to you, O Lord. We thank you for your prophets on earth. Help us to be prophets in our own way, to bring others closer to you".

WE TALK: What kind of prophet am I? To whom am I a prophet? What words or actions do I show as a prophet of God? Do I practice what I preach?

WE ACT: Our family will light the second candle of our Advent wreath this week during our meals together. We will pray for or help someone in need. Whom will that be?

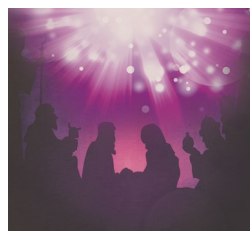
