As Catholics, we are all called to care for the earth and be good stewards of the environment. In *Care for Our Common Home (Laudato Si')*, Pope Francis asks "every person living on this planet" for an inclusive dialogue about how we are shaping the future of our planet. Pope Francis calls on the Church and the world to acknowledge the urgency of our environmental challenges and to join him in embarking on a new path. Next weekend during Mass times, our parish is taking up this call and will be making initiatives and asking our parishioners to help us all "go green," specifically through three separate methods:

WHAT IS E-WASTE?

E-waste is a popular, informal name for electronic products nearing the end of their "useful life." Computers, televisions, VCRs, stereos, copiers, and fax machines are common electronic products. Many of these products can be reused, refurbished, or recycled. Certain components of some electronic products contain materials that render them hazardous, depending on their condition and density. It is best to recycle products you do not use that are very old or cannot be repaired. **Bring your old electronics to church next weekend at all 4 of our parish churches. We will be accepting old computers and supplies, TVs, monitors, & electronics. No air conditioners, refrigerators or dehumidifiers please.**

Seventh Sunday of Easter

Our Liturgical color for the Easter season is:

WHITE

Gospel Understanding: John 17:20-21: The short Gospel passage this week is part of a much longer "High Priestly Prayer" from John's account of The Last Supper. Jesus is praying that unity will always be honored among his followers. Jesus, our Father in heaven, and the Holy Spirit are in loving unity. To understand and witness to their unity, we must also develop a spirit of unity in our own lives. Jesus' followers must remain united in order to keep, model, and proclaim the Gospel message. This passage from John's Gospel became the inspiration for a whole new era of good relations between the Catholic Church and other Christian churches. The progress made in Christian unity since the early 1960s gives powerful evidence of the true work of the Holy Spirit in the world. In communities all around the world, Christians continue this spirit of unity by praying together, studying together on college campuses, and discussing important points of human and spiritual life to continue to develop unity.

We Pray: "Father, Son and Holy Spirit, you are united in love. There is great joy in being united in you. We pray for unity in our family and in our world, among all peoples. We believe that with you, we can stand up to any difficulty. Amen."

We Talk: How do I help unite people in my life (at home, school, work, in our community)? What positive actions help unite people? What negative actions divide people?

We Act: This week, we will decide on one action which will unite people in our family or in our community.

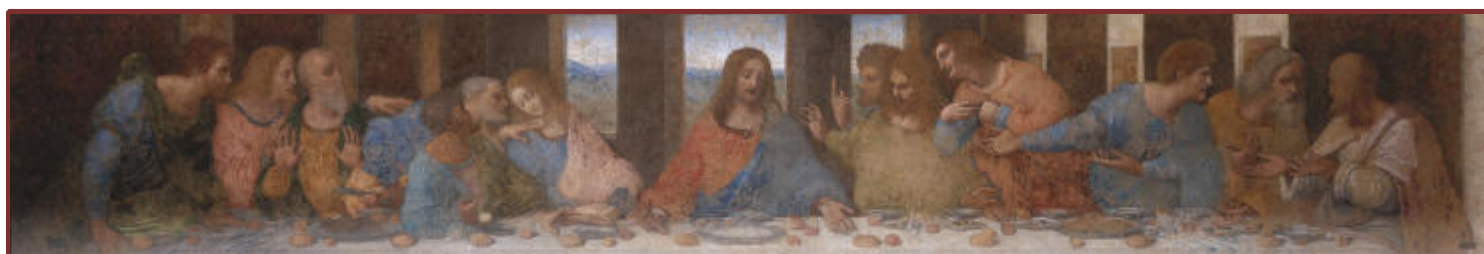

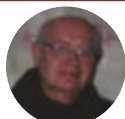

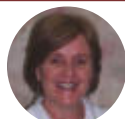
