



Family Faith Formation

THIS WEEK AT HOME

1st Sunday of Lent

LET US PRAY

Jesus, I trust in You....

GOSPEL BACKGROUND

Turning points can be times of doubt and insecurity. Jesus' response to the temptations of the devil offers an example for responding in faith when our doubts and insecurities tempt us to distrust God's sufficiency. Jesus rebukes the devil by quoting Scripture. Each citation is an affirmation of trust in God. We learn to trust in big things by practicing trust in little things. Our Lenten practices of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving invite us to trust God in these small ways. They remind us that God will suffice for us. They prepare us to trust in God in all things, especially in moments of doubt and uncertainty.

LUKE 4: 1-13

Filled with the Holy Spirit, Jesus returned from the Jordan and was led by the Spirit into the desert for forty days, to be tempted by the devil. He ate nothing during those days, and when they were over He was hungry. The devil said to Him, "If you are the Son of God, command this stone to become bread." Jesus answered him, "It is written, One does not live on bread alone." Then he took Him up and showed Him all the kingdoms of the world in a single instant. The devil said to Him, "I shall give to You all this power and glory; for it has been handed over to me, and I may give it to whomever I wish. All this will be Yours, if You worship me." Jesus said to him in reply, "It is written, You shall worship the Lord, your God, and Him alone shall you serve." Then he led Him to Jerusalem, made Him stand on the parapet of the temple, and said to Him, "If you are the Son of God, throw Yourself down from here, for it is written: He will command His angels concerning You, to guard You,and: With their hands they will support You, lest You dash Your foot against a stone." Jesus said to him in reply, "It also says, You shall not put the Lord, your God, to the test." When the devil had finished every temptation, he departed from Him for a time.

FAMILY CONVERSATION

Discuss how Jesus showed His trust in God when He resisted the devil's temptations. Invite family members to name times when they have trusted God in matters small or large. Write a family prayer together. You might write the prayer so that each line begins with a letter in the word "trust." Pray this prayer together.

Will I follow the path of Jesus?

"The Word is near you, on your lips and in your heart."
Jesus the Eternal Word continues to call many to lives of holiness as priests, deacons, and in the consecrated life.

We hope to gather in person at St. Mary's depending on COVID, if not we'll meet on ZOOM. Any adult who has experienced the death of a loved one, is welcome to participate at no charge. participate at no charge.

Grieving is painful and confusing, unsettling to say the least. It's easy to get stuck and wonder if we'll ever enjoy the fullness of life again. Death's seismic shifts in our world's (both externally and internally) affect our hearts, minds, bodies and souls. With this in mind "Living With Grief" is designed to help participants move through grief in a small caring, constructive, supportive community.

These sessions are designed for participants to:

- share their experiences in a confidential, nonjudgmental setting
- study the dynamics of grief and the effects of grief on everyday living
 explore the vital role spirituality plays in healing
 move forward in hope and over time find acceptance and perhaps
- even joy in the midst of loss
