



### Sharing God's Word ~ Through Faith Formation

### FROM OUR DIRECTOR OF FAITH FORMATION

### The Series Begins October 6

Yes, I know the MLB wild card series begins this Friday, not Thursday. If you turn your TV on on October 6th expecting baseball, you'll be disappointed. Nevertheless, this is not false advertising: our adult faith formation series begins this Thursday! Sessions will be at 10:30 AM at Holy Martyrs and 6:30 PM at Sacred Heart.

Our topic for this month is on dying well. Many of you are thinking baseball was a heck of a lot cheerier and you'd be right in some ways (depending on your team, I suppose), but this is one of the most important topics we can cover, which is why I think it was one of the most popular in the survey we conducted earlier this summer. Human beings were put on this earth to know, love, and serve God in this life in order to be happy with Him forever in the next. Death is no one's idea of a good time, but on the other side of it is the hope of Heaven; and that is quite cheery, to the say least.

As a preview of coming attractions, allow me to anticipate a possible objection: does it make sense to talk about dying well or dying poorly? Is there such thing as a good death and how much can you praise or blame a person for how they die? After all, whether a person dies from influenza or from a wrong turn off the state pier usually isn't in their control. Dying is something that just happens to people. It will happen to all of us eventually, so why bother talking about it?

If you've been with people when they pass, you know that they do so in very different ways: some are inspiring, and some are far from it. Some are well prepared to meet Our Lord and go with great love and confidence in Him. Some are scrambling to decide whether or not they even have a soul. Some offer their sufferings up heroically for other people. Others endure them bitterly.

In saying this, I'm not judging anyone; the dying process is incredibly hard. However, there are things we should consider now, so that we spend our last days well. It is possible to die well, with great faith, great hope, and great love. To do this, we need to prepare now. We don't magically gain great trust in God the moment we're faced with our own mortality; we don't instantly repent of our sins the moment we realize we're running out of time to do so. If we form those habits now, they will carry us through that most difficult time of our life at the end and help us cross the finish line to Heaven. The Bible, the saints, and the teachings of the Church will be our guides as we dive into this topic. We hope to see you there!


