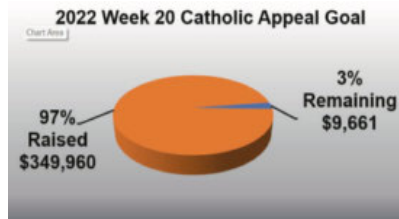

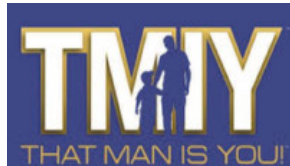

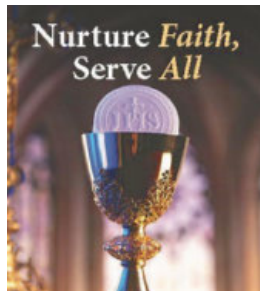

ADULT FAITH FORMATION—ON DYING WELL: Our director of faith formation, Joe Moreshead, is offering a four-part series on dying well during the month of October. Our final moments on this earth are precious, and it is important that we think now about how we hope to use them. The remaining talks will be held on Thursdays, October 13, 20, and 27 at 10:30 AM at Holy Martyrs and 6:30 PM at Sacred Heart. Morning talks will be live streamed on our website in the *Watch Masses Live* section at <https://pothe.org/watchmasslive> and posted later with handouts under *On Dying Well*, <https://pothe.org/on-dying-well>.

MAINE CATHOLIC CEMETERIES: Last week we published the first of nine articles intended to educate Maine Catholics about the benefits afforded by our Catholic cemeteries, and to share Church teaching on Catholic burial practices. Our second article in the series is titled, *Three Sacred Moments Part 1*. Each

spring, the Church gathers the faithful to celebrate the Sacred Triduum, three sacred moments celebrating the Passion, death, and Resurrection of Our Lord. Following the passing of a loved one, the Church gathers the faithful at three sacred moments as well. This week, we examine the first of these three gatherings, commonly referred to as the "Vigil". The Vigil is sometimes the most difficult part of the funeral rites as family members and friends gather at a funeral home and confront the reality of our loss. As such, the Vigil offers an opportunity for prayerful support of each other and the deceased. The Vigil prayer service consists of an opening rite, the reading of God's Word, a brief homily or reflection, prayers of intercession, and a blessing prayer. Sharing fond memories of the deceased at the Vigil helps to begin the process of psychological and spiritual healing that will continue in the days ahead. Giving thought and preparing for our own passing is a loving gift to our family.
