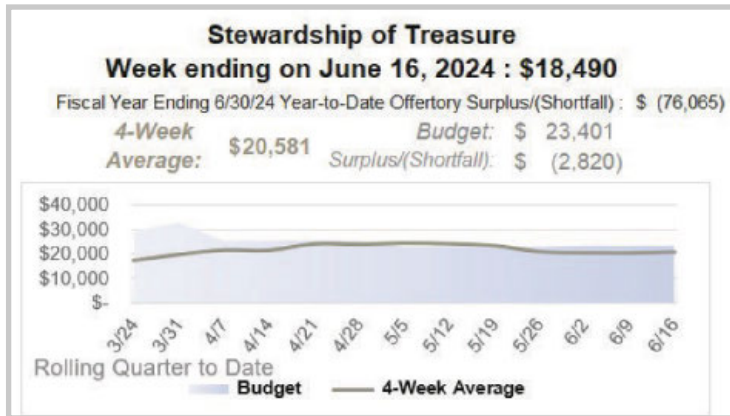

FROM OUR DIRECTOR OF FAITH FORMATION

THE PRAYER FOR GENEROSITY: PART 1

When I was a student at Cheverus High School, there were two prayers from St. Ignatius that we said regularly: the Suscipe ("Take, Lord, and receive all my liberty") and the Prayer for Generosity. Writing on the North American Martyrs these past few weeks has brought it back to mind. It went as follows:

Lord, teach me to be generous.
Teach me to serve You as You
deserve;
to give and not to count the
cost,
to fight and not to heed the
wounds,
to toil and not to seek for rest,
to labour and not to ask for
reward,
save that of knowing that I do
Your will.



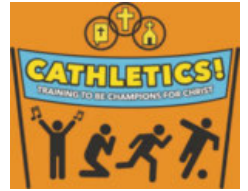
"Teach me to serve You as You deserve." That was one thing that Jesuit education did a good job of drilling into us: our lives were given to us by God and were meant to be used in His service. Especially for teenagers, the concept of always saying "yes" to what was asked of us was a bit of a hill to climb. Thinking back, I think I would describe my freshman self as benignantly willful. While good natured and generally wanting to be kind, I was convinced of the brilliance of my own ideas and focused on my own plans to such a degree that the concept of having to serve anyone, let alone God, was a little foreign. What did I owe God? In fact, I owed Him everything.

I was at that age where I was just beginning to discover the truth that "it is better to give than to receive." There's a real joy in self forgetfulness that in theory never sounds appealing, but in practice makes for a good and happy life. Mother Teresa used to say, "We were made for greater things: to love and to be loved." I always figured that was the explanation for it. When our efforts are directed at doing good for someone else, we live for what we are made for, and there is joy in that. When we strive to serve God, to do good for Him, that is even more true.

So how to serve God well? How to love Him as He deserves? It means giving without counting the cost. You could apply this principle in a broader manner, but I used to think about this especially in terms of charity. When you see someone else in need, is your focus on them and their need or on you and the opportunities it's costing you? This was certainly easier for me when I was a student and not responsible for much of anything. Whatever money I had was spending money and it wasn't all that much. Mother Teresa used to talk about "giving until it hurts." The most valuable gifts are the ones that do cost us, but that we give anyway out of love.
