I can recall, when my kids came off the school bus after a long day at school, they needed to share all that they had learned and done during the day. Well, at least the girls did. Many times, they ran in the house shouting, "Mum, Mum, guess what we did today?" When the boys came off the bus, they headed straight for the refrigerator to refuel after their day!

The disciples returning from their mission, must have been so excited by all they had seen and taught! The power of the Holy Spirit would have energized them so! Jesus, recognizing the need for them to rest, recharge and refuel after their excursions, invites them to come away to a guiet place and rest for a while.

The people however, had other ideas. Jesus' popularity is growing and everyone is looking for a chance to see him. This time, however, Jesus does not heal or perform miracles, at least not yet. We are told, "he saw a great crowd; and he had compassion for them, because they were like sheep without a shepherd; and he began to teach them many things."

Jesus met the crowds with compassion first and then restored their wellbeing. This great crowd that followed him, did not know what it was they were looking for. Like sheep without a shepherd, they wandered around aimlessly, helpless and lost. They just knew they needed something. Jesus takes the time to teach them how to take care of their spiritual selves. He taught them many things; to build the foundation of truth that would sustain them when life was hard and he was not with them in person.

We are the same. On our own without Jesus, we are helpless and lost. When we get too busy, too involved with life to make time for Jesus, we find ourselves relying on our own abilities rather than seeking out God's plan for us. "Be still and know that I am God." Take time to breathe. Where do we find Jesus? In the quiet in our hearts.

The disciples who were sent out, returned to Jesus to share in their adventures and recount all that they had said and done. We need to do the same thing. Return to Jesus often to talk to him, tell him about your adventures, share your hopes and dreams with him. Share your doubts and fears and ask him whatever questions are on your heart. All of us need time alone with Christ. If we do not take care of our spiritual selves, we can fall apart, become unraveled and lack focus in our lives.

God welcomes us with open arms to heal us with his grace. The church is the deserted place we come to for refreshment and energy in order to go back out again. The reception of the Eucharist and the sacrament of Reconciliation, energizes and heals us. Come, sit awhile. Be at peace! Be renewed! Be made ready to go out into the world!


