

Weekly Reflection

19th and 20th Sunday in Ordinary Time August 7 & 14, 2022

Many times, I am asked if I like my job. This question always causes me to pause for a moment before I answer. Hmm, what goes through my mind when asked? How do I answer this question? I think sometimes the question really being asked is "why do I do my job?" Of course, I very much enjoy what I do, but this is what I am called to do. This is God's call, God's will for me! Having said this, how then can I not do what I do. Is every day filled with joy and success? Not necessarily. Could I just leave and do something else because things don't always go well? Not for one minute could I think about this. I don't do my work just to enjoy myself. I do this because it matters, because it is right, because this is what God wants me to do.

In today's Gospel from Luke, Jesus sounds impatient with his disciples. Jesus said to his disciples, "I came to bring fire to the earth, and how I wish it were already kindled!" Jesus knows what is to come for him. A painful death, disciples who will deny him, followers who will no longer follow him and the division that will occur in families as some will choose to believe in Jesus and some will not. Yes, Jesus came to bring division. Jesus came not for us to live a life of tranquility but to keep the fires burning that he started while on earth with us. Yes, we are called to change! We are not to shy away from defending our faith even when it causes family strife. To be a follower of Jesus will not be easy!

It is hard to see and encounter those that do not follow Jesus. It is difficult to watch people not living out Gospel values in their lives. It is sad to encounter those that do not believe that judgement will come on the last day. It causes me pain to see those who do not believe in the real presence of the Body of Christ in the Eucharist. It causes me distress to know that those who do not put God first in their life will be judged harshly on the last day.

While I cannot solve all the problems of those that I encounter, I can be a witness to them of what a life lived in Christ can be like. It is frustrating sometimes to know that you can't make a difference. No matter whom I encounter or what my experience with them, I always do my best to love them where they are at.

We live in a broken, divided world. Many of our families find themselves divided and in conflict with each other due to the fact that not all family members live according to Gospel values. Whether the issue be over attending Mass, engagement in social justice issues, or even about how we pray, the Gospel's effects can create division. It is important to note, however, that how we respond to those divisions does not make us as appear as hypocrites.

In times of division, know that the Gospel shared with an individual, will do its work and we are to trust God in his work. We must resist the temptation to control the outcome. Jesus seeks out bold followers. Do not shy away from conflicts but trust that the Holy Spirit is with you in all that you do!
