



# Weekly Reflection

#### Reflection November 27, & December 4, 2022, First & Second Sundays of Advent

Have you ever prepared yourself for company coming to visit at your house? You make sure the bathrooms are clean and the house is dust free and tidy. Perhaps your company is coming over for a meal? Before they show up, you do all the prep work ahead of time. This way, you can spend as much time as possible with your friends.

But what if the company gets the date wrong and they come over to your house, a day early? Then what? Panic sets in! The house is not clean. The meat is still in the freezer. You answer the door with a look of surprise and upset on your face and as luck would have it, you are wearing ugly grubby work clothes. I heard something once, long time ago, probably when the "What Would Jesus Do" bracelets were popular, if Jesus came to your house for an unexpected visit, would you need to change your clothes, change the channel on the television or the radio, or would you run and hide? Sounds familiar. Yes, this Sunday's Gospel is all about being ready for the unexpected and unknown timing of Jesus second coming.

This is the First Sunday of Advent. Advent is the time in which we get ready to celebrate the birthday of Jesus. The scripture tells us to be alert, be ready, stay awake for we do not know the hour that Jesus will come again. Perhaps as we start Advent, this would be a good time to reflect on our year. How did you do this past year? Did you deepen your spiritual life with faith-based reading of books or videos? Did you participate in a small prayer group? Were you able to support a charity or family in need? Did you bring joy to those around you?

Yes, wake up! Wake up and see what is missing in your life. Like the scripture says, you do not know when the thief is coming. Watch out for the "thief" in your life. Don't make this Advent just another thing to "get done." Do not let the thief rob you of your joy. Father Thom has mentioned this in his homily; we all wear a badge of "busy." Too often when someone asks how we are, our response is "busy." This can turn into a competition to see who is the busiest, who puts in the most hours at work, who has the most commitments to fulfill and so on. This response will rob you of your joy. You won't even notice it at first but little by little, instead of a joyful response, you will feel burdened, sad even and worse, make the other person you are conversing with, feel sad also.

Well, that thief will come at an unexpected hour just like unexpected company. When we know the company is coming, we are prepared. So should we be ready to celebrate the birth of Jesus and to welcome him when he returns once again. Let's welcome him with joy. Let's put the busy badge aside this Advent and look for the joy around us! Let us be the joy of Christ to all those we encounter this Advent season!





The specific way that Jesus asks you to love him in return is to spend time with him in the Blessed Sacrament. It is very important that Jesus is never left alone during Adoration. In order to have Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament it is crucial that you sign up to ensure that someone (at least one but the more the better) will always be present with Jesus during Adoration. "Could you not watch one hour with me?"

# **Hospitality Ministry**

The mission of the hospitality ministry is to provide a welcoming environment of love, acceptance, comfort, support, care, and unity for visitors, members, guests, and friends in order to enhance their worship experience, and encourage discipleship.



Hospitality is a form of outreach to all those who come to our churches for any reason.

There are many ways to do this. For example, greeting those who come to us for Mass on the weekends. But hospitality does not begin and end with the Sunday Mass experience. Hospitality and welcome, is needed for all the events we organize in our parishes. As we begin our sacramental preparation programs, volunteers are needed to greet people, answer questions, give directions, provide refreshments, and to be networkers by talking to those who come to us.



# Light up for Christ and Celebrate the Feast of Saint Nicholas


