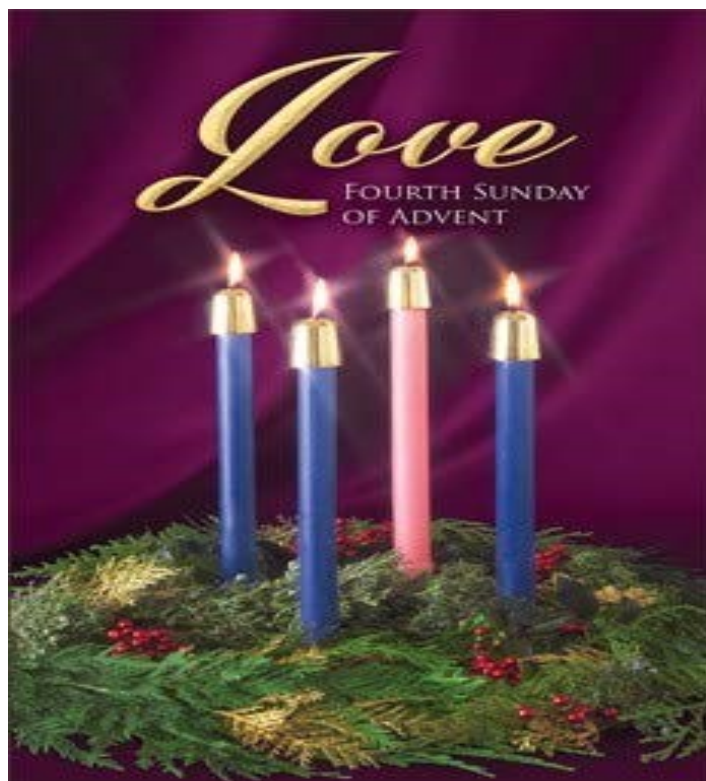
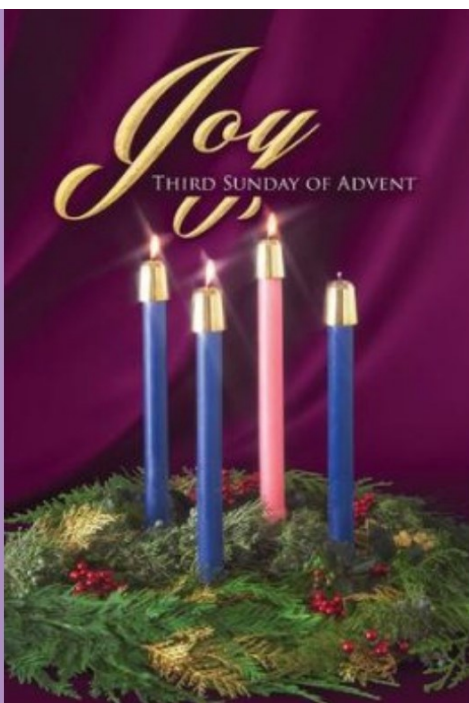

## Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament

If Jesus were actually visible in church, everyone would run to welcome him, but he remains hidden in the Sacred Host under the appearance of bread, because he is calling us to faith that we may come to him in humility, and it is our duty to honour and adore the Blessed Host. He is really there!



The specific way that Jesus asks you to love him in return is to spend time with him in the Blessed Sacrament. It is very important that Jesus is never left alone during Adoration. In order to have Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament it is crucial that you sign up to ensure that someone (at least one but the more the better) will always be present with Jesus during Adoration. "Could you not watch one hour with me?"

**\*During Advent: Adoration will take place every Friday at All Saints Parish. It will follow the morning Mass for one hour.**

# *Weekly Reflection*

## **Reflection December 11 & 18, 2022 The Third and Fourth Sundays of Advent**

As we continue to wait and prepare for the birth of our Saviour, in the scripture for the third week of Advent, Jesus quotes Old Testament saying, "See, I am sending my messenger ahead of you, who will prepare your way before the Lord." Jesus is referring of course, to John the Baptist, the one sent to prepare the way.

Who do we have in our midst who prepare the way for us? What resources do we use to prepare ourselves for Christmas? How do we witness to others about the real presence of God in the world? What or who do we place our faith in? Do we have a plan for our life that relies and trusts in God to provide for us or do we rely on ourselves thinking we are in control. To trust in God completely requires tremendous faith to let go and let God. We need to be radical in our trust.

I came across the piece I am quoting below, as part of my daily Advent reflections. Written by Henri Nouwen, the reflection gave me pause to stop and think, I mean really think. It is titled "Radical Waiting"

"I have found it very important in my own life to try to let go of my wishes and instead to live in hope. I am finding that when I choose to let go of my sometimes petty and superficial wishes and trust that my life is precious and meaningful in the eyes of God, something really new, something beyond my own expectations begins to happen in me.

To wait with openness and trust is an enormously radical attitude toward life. It is choosing to hope that something is happening for us that is far beyond our own imaginings. It is giving up control over our future and letting God define our life. It is living with the conviction that God molds us in love, holds us in tenderness, and moves us away from the sources of our fear.

Our spiritual life is a life in which we wait, actively present to the moment, expecting that new things will happen to us, new things that are far beyond our own imagination or prediction. This, indeed, is a very radical stance toward life in a world preoccupied with control."

Well said, Henri!

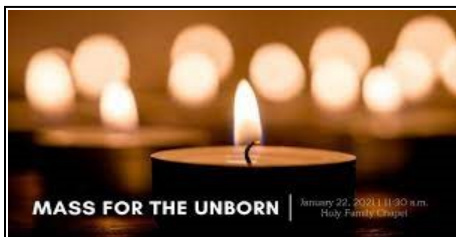
