



Weekly Reflection

Reflection January 8, Epiphany of the Lord, the 2nd. Sunday in Ordinary Time, January 15, 2023

So, here we are in a new year! How many times will you write 2022 on something instead of 2023 before it becomes habit to do so? Change takes time. Change will happen with or without us. Question is, do we meet change head on or do we struggle just to keep up?

The scripture reading for January 8, the Epiphany of the Lord, reveals the divine nature of Jesus Christ as the manifestation of Christ to the Gentiles is represented by the arrival of the Magi. The visit from the Wise Men brings forth a moment of sudden revelation and insight into what the birth of Jesus means for us. God is among us! Great change is here!

The scripture reading for January 15, tells of John the Baptist baptizing with water with the invitation to repent of one's sins. John the Baptist knows though, that there is one to come who will baptize with the Holy Spirit. Yes, great change is here!

In the second reading for January 15, Paul's greeting is addressed to "those who are sanctified in Christ Jesus, called to be saints, together with all those who in every place call on the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, both their Lord and ours." Yes, we are all called to be saints. The greatest disappointment though, is that we do not realize this calling to sainthood. Impossible you say, to be a saint, not so.

Sainthood starts with small things. Small things become significant not to us but to those that receive them. Yes, we are called to do great things but the greatness comes from the effort and not from the act itself.

We are called to become saints, to be perfected in charity, to grow in holiness. Not only are we called to this, it is now made possible through Jesus Christ. We are to live differently - beginning right now- because we live our lives now in Jesus Christ. We are to love differently, because we are enabled by grace to love in Jesus Christ. And all of this is made possible, as we cooperate with grace. The character of Christ is being formed in us as we cooperate with grace.


New Year, new opportunity. New chances. No time like the present to make changes.

January 2023 Update - 37 Frank Youth Centre

On behalf of 37 Frank Youth Centre (YFC/Youth Unlimited Strathroy) - we would like to wish you a happy New Year and thank you all for your support of prayers, money, food, and donations that you have given to help support this amazing cause.

In my summer update, we were seeing approximately one hundred youth come in during the week. Currently, we can see up to fifty per day. The need is there - and it is a great place for youth from ages 13-25 to have a safe, warm place to hang out.

We had approximately twenty-five youth come and celebrate Christmas at Frank's this year and for many of the young people, this would have been their only Christmas celebration. They were each given presents and you could see through the tears in their eyes that they know they are each loved and cared for. We truly are Frank's family.

In late September/October this past year, a male aged sixteen, was living in a bush in a tent on his own for nearly two weeks. We were able to help him get some temporary shelter though the County of Middlesex and he has now been able to find stable housing. There are a number of youths that come into Frank's that do not have a safe home to go to or no home at all. They are couch surfing and getting by. This is not acceptable! We are going to have a warming centre opened before the end of this calendar year. We cannot have any youth living in a forest or on the street. One homeless person in our area is one too many.

We are now in the process of working on our largest fundraiser of the year for the centre. This is the Coldest Night of the Year (CNOY). It is being held on Saturday, February 25, 2023. Our goal this year is to raise \$75,000. It is a 2 km walk - starting at 37 Frank Street. Money raised will not only help us continue to run Frank's Cafe, but it will be used to help us start the warming centre.

Sponsorship Newsletter

Quite a few things have happened since we last published a Sponsorship Newsletter.

Eric, Sheila, and Family

Eric and Sheila (Our current sponsorship) are now into the second half of their sponsorship year, and they are gradually adjusting to their new lives in Canada. Eric has been surprised by the differences in culture and the pace of life in Canada. Sheila loves Canada but hates the cold and snow. The children love school. Eric is working for Cuddy Farms, in their Strathroy hatchery, and thoroughly enjoys the work.

Background

In 2008, Eric was forced by the ruthless Congolese rebels to flee for his life. He fled to Kampala in Uganda and became a refuge. Subsequently he lost all contact with all family members, including his mum and dad. Several years later he did remake contact with his brother Hervé, in Kampala, after Hervé had also been forced to flee from the rebels.

A few months after Eric, Sheila and four children arrived in Canada and Strathroy in June 2022. a friend in Kampala contacted Eric to say, he thought he had seen Eric's mum in Kampala. We had a mass offered for Eric to find his mother and within five days, the sighting had been confirmed.

We don't have sufficient space here to tell the horror story of how Eric's mum, Marie Claire came to be a refugee herself. Suffice to say that this very courageous lady arrived in Kampala as a widow with two orphaned grandchildren. Marie Claire arrived in Kampala, just a few weeks after Eric and family had left for Canada.

Of course, our Family of Parishes Sponsorship Team is trying to bring Marie Claire, her two grandchildren and son Hervé, here to Canada. With the expert support of Gilbert and Auday in the Diocesan Refugee Office we have now completed the necessary mountain of paperwork, required by the Canadian Government. Because there are still many processes required by our Federal Government, including all family members being extensively

interviewed by Embassy officials in Kampala, this could be a two year process. For our part it has truly been a privilege to be able to reach out to this courageous lady and help her and her family.

On New Year's Eve, Hervé was attacked in his tiny one room home, by eight men, one wielding an 18 inch sword. Hervé received a gash to his leg and was throttled until unconscious. He awoke in hospital, where a good neighbour had taken him. The men took everything Hervé had, his old cell phone, his mattress and a few other bits and pieces.

Other sponsorship news

In recent months our Diocesan Refugee Team have agreed to work with an international refugee charity, Lamp, Lifeboat, Ladder with their sponsorship of especially vulnerable refugees; people who have suffered significant trauma, such as torture. As part of this initiative, our Family of Parishes Sponsorship Team has offered to take a mother called Slah, her husband and two children, sometime in the first half of 2023. Slah and family are Sudanese and currently refugees in Jordon.

Additionally, because we have recently expanded the size of the Sponsorship Team and now have sufficient members for two teams, we have offered to take a second family, probably in the second half of 2023. At this stage we don't have any details for this family, but we will keep you informed.
