





## Weekly Reflection

#### Reflection February 5th and February 12th, the Fifth and Sixth Sundays in Ordinary Time

I find the words Jesus says to his disciples in scripture, rather intimidating. Jesus says "You are the light of the world. A city on a hill cannot be hidden." Even more intimidating, Jesus goes on to say, "let your light shine before human beings, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father in heaven." This is quite the responsibility we have been given, to let our light shine out so that all may see it! Not only are we to do this but let our light shine out so that people will recognize God in us and as a result, give glory to God!

Indeed, this is not about us! This is the call to do the work of Jesus in whatever part of the world, no matter how big or how small our world is that we live in, and let our light shine out to those around us. I think some of us might need new light bulbs.

While on vacation earlier this year with my family, we attended the evening entertainment at the resort we were at. An old familiar song was being sung by the Michael Jackson impersonator, "Heal the World." Beautiful lyrics, "heal the world, make it a better place, for you and for me and the entire human race." We all sang along, at least those of us old enough to remember the song, and in no time at all, everyone in the audience pulled out their phones, and lit up the venue with the flashlight mode on their phone. There we sat, singing, swaying to the music and holding our flashlights high for all to see!

Interesting social phenomena to be so moved by a song we just have to let our light shine! Now, apply this principle to life in general. Imagine the positive effect you could have on others around you if, when you are so moved by the Spirit, to light up the world around you, with your smile, your words of kindness, your joy spilling out onto others, and not be intimidated by what others might think of you.

Just as my family and I all wanted to be part of the moving experience created by hearing a beautiful song, we can be part of the greatest experience ever offered, life lived in Jesus Christ!

So how about giving it a try? Let your light shine out for all to see. Next time you are doing good works, remember this is not about you but about others seeing Jesus in you. Let our good works bring others to Christ and give glory to God! You may never know, how a little light spread around to others, will affect them. Crank up the wattage! Don't leave anyone in the dark! As Catherine of Siena would say, "If you are what you should be, you will set the whole world on fire."







Ash Wednesday (February 22) marks the beginning of Lent for Christians throughout the world. Lent is the penitential season of prayer, fasting and almsgiving from Ash Wednesday through Holy Thursday, in preparation for Easter. It is also the time for catechumens — those who have not been fully received into the Catholic Church — to prepare for the sacraments of initiation including Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Eucharist. The 40-day period of Lent culminates in Holy Week.

The Liturgy of the Hours, also known as the Divine Office, is a beautiful and ancient tradition in the Church that is not reserved for priests and religious, but can also be prayed by the lay faithful. The Second Vatican Council highly encouraged the laity to "recite the divine office, either with the priests, or among themselves, or even individually" (Sacrosanctum Concilium, 100).

The Liturgy of the Hours is the prayer of the whole People of God. In it, Christ himself "continues his priestly work through his Church." His members participate according to their own place in the Church and the circumstances of their lives.

During Lent, at each church site, you are invited to participate in the praying of the Liturgy of the Hours and Adoration. Worship aids will be provided along with some instruction as to how you can participate.
