

Weekly Reflection

Reflection for Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ June 11, and the 11th Sunday in Ordinary Time, June 18, 2023

When my children were very young and being introduced to new foods, sometimes it was a struggle to even get them to try it. They could not and would not be convinced, what I was offering was both good for them and tasted good! Usually, a struggle ensued and the food to be tasted ended up all over the highchair, the child and me!

In today's Gospel reading, Jesus leaves no doubt that we are to consume his body and blood in order to gain life everlasting. "Very truly, I tell you, unless you eat the flesh of the son of Man and drink his blood, you have no life in you." What does this mean to have no life in us?

If this text is a meditation on the Eucharist, then part of the point is that the Eucharist is life-giving because it is Jesus who gives it, and it is life-giving because it is Jesus himself who is given. The Eucharist is life-giving because it draws us deeper into relationship with Jesus, so that we may "abide" there. There can be no proper understanding of the Eucharist apart from this life-giving participation in the life and the death of Jesus himself.

Forcing a choice between hearing these words as a statement about believing in Jesus or hearing them as a statement about receiving him in the Eucharist would be to drive apart what chapter 6 joins together. Without the familiar story of the last supper, this text is the primary reflection on the Eucharist in John. With that in mind, we need to notice the clear and insistent focus on Jesus himself as the one given by the Father, the one who is the Bread of Life from Heaven, the one on whom we must feed.

Do not lose sight of what is really important, eternal life in Jesus.

The first Apostles, in Matthew are named, given their mission and power to do everything Jesus was doing while he was on earth.

"Jesus saw the crowds, he had compassion for them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd." "Then Jesus summoned the twelve disciples and gave them authority over unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to cure every disease and every sickness."

This calling continues today. Jesus still calls, as he called the twelve, to continue the loving ministry of Jesus in the world. At baptism, we receive the water of God's love and the oil of service, completed in confirmation, marriage and ordination. The needs of God's people are as great today as then. In a world of addiction, suicide, confusion, poverty, injustice and many other big needs, Jesus still looks and sees people 'like sheep without a shepherd'. He calls each of us, male and female, young and old into his service.

Jesus' mission was to spread the gospel to all people. In Matthew, we see Jesus' compassion for those who are lost and His desire to save them. Jesus' message is one of love and forgiveness, and his example is one that we should all follow.

The conclusion of this passage is that Jesus is the only way to be saved. The devotional meaning of this passage is that we need to turn to Jesus to be saved from our sins. We can't save ourselves, and we can't do it on our own. We need to rely on Jesus to save us.

In Matthew, Jesus reflects on the importance of service and how it connects us to God. He also encourages us to always put others first, and to show compassion to others. These teachings are important, and they can help us to live our lives in a way that is pleasing to God.

In today's world, it can be easy to feel lost and alone. But Jesus reminds us that we are never alone, and that we can always find refuge in Him. In Matthew, Jesus teaches us about the importance of mercy and forgiveness, and how we can show them to others.

Jesus calls you and I today just as he called the twelve then. How do you plan to answer? Pray for the opportunity and the courage to serve. Pray for the grace of the Eucharist to fill you up spiritually so fully, you are filled with the Spirit and have no fear, working to proclaim his holy name. Whenever you have doubts, think about what Jesus gave for you, his very life!




