





Weekly Reflection

Reflection for the 12th and 13th Sundays in Ordinary Time, June 25 and July 2, 2023

For those of you that know me, I have been blessed with a really full head of thick hair. I have been told; I will never have to worry about going bald. Keeping it short makes it more manageable for me and takes less time each day to wash and go. I could not even begin though, to count the hairs on my head.

The Gospel we hear this week and next, tells us, God knows us so well, that he does know how many hairs are on our heads. This is how intimately God knows us and how wonderfully he cares for us.

Last week, we began to hear in Matthew chapter 10, Jesus naming his disciples and giving them their instructions for ministry. The Gospel for the next two weeks, continues with those instructions.

How many of us used fear to raise our kids? What I mean is, when there was a danger or something unsafe, we used fear to keep our kids away from it. We say, "don't touch the stove. It's hot." This was done out of love for our kids and that parental desire to keep our kids safe. Jesus does the same thing with the disciples warning them of all the things to come. Sounds like to me a good reason to turn and run. No, Jesus prepares them, so they are ready to take on the challenge when they meet it.

The threat of death may be the most powerful form of fear Jesus uses. Jesus' next expression of reassurance addresses this fear directly. Jesus admits that humans exercise this power, but notes that they have power only to kill the body, not the whole person. God alone can destroy both soul and body; God alone, therefore, is the one we should fear.

Jesus' mission discourse is a "get-out-the-volunteers" campaign like no other. On the one hand, the disciples are granted remarkable powers to heal, exorcise demons, cleanse lepers, even to raise the dead. But he also denies them money, pay, extra clothes, a staff for protection, even sandals. They are to undertake their mission in complete vulnerability and dependence on God, even knowing that they go as "sheep in the midst of wolves," face arrests and beatings, opposition even from family members, and hatred and persecution.

When God calls us to speak for him, we are to depend on him to teach us what to say. Jesus said to his Apostles: "Whoever loves father or mother more than me is not worthy of me; and whoever loves son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me; and whoever does not take up their cross and follow me is not worthy of me. Whoever finds their life will lose it, and whoever loses their life for my sake will find it." In other words, the call to discipleship renders secondary all other claims upon one's identity and allegiance, even to father or mother, or son or daughter. We are first and foremost, missionary disciples for Christ!

Jesus tells us not to worry. We are far more valuable than the sparrows. Sparrows were sold in the marketplace, two for a penny. The tiny birds were sold for their meat. They were pretty insignificant little things, but none the less, God watches over them. If God cares about the birds that fall from the air, the tiny birds sold for meat in the market, imagine how much more God cares for us. We are his children whom he loves.

It is not so easy following Christ each and every day, but that is what we are called to do. Our faith is not to be kept secret—we are to uncover those things which are covered up and to make known those things which are secret. What you hear in the dark, say in the light; what is whispered, proclaim from the housetops. It is in and through suffering that we grow in love for God and our neighbors. And we as followers of Jesus are called to be with the sick, to comfort the dying, to console those grieving, to understand the troubles, to care about others as God cares for us. Remember, God has counted every hair on our head! We are his beloved!

Here's to a restful summer and we hope you join us in September.


