



What is the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults?


The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is the name given to the process by which those seeking to join the Catholic Church, go through as they seek to know more about themselves and their relationship with God.



The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is a spiritual journey of formation, prayer and discernment by both the individual and the Parish community. It is designed for adults and children of catechetical age (in their seventh year) who consciously and freely seek God and want to enter into the life of faith as disciples of Jesus. This journey of faith leads to the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist at the Easter Vigil.

RCIA is also appropriate for those who are baptized in another Christian denomination and wish to become Catholic and for Catholics who were baptized as infants but did not complete their initiation as a young person.

RCIA begins Tuesday October 3, at All Saints parish center. Contact Father Thom (tblondin@dol.ca) or Julie de Gouw (jdegouw@dol.ca) for more information.

Weekly Reflection

Reflection for September 17 and September 24, the Twenty Fourth and Twenty Fifth Sundays in Ordinary Time

We are about to start preparations with our grade 2 children for First Reconciliation in our family of parishes. If there is one thing, we want these children to take away from the preparation it is this; there is nothing you can do to make God love you less. Think about this for a minute. There is nothing, nothing, nothing, you can do to make God love you less!

You can whine and complain that life isn't fair. You can hold onto a grudge. You can think awful things about someone. But there is nothing you can do to make God love you less.

In the Gospel readings for the next two weeks, Matthew reveals to us that Jesus tells us we must always forgive others and respect God's wisdom and judgement in how he deals with us. The scripture passages bring to light human conditions that we ourselves experience. We know what it is to feel resentment when you think you have not been dealt with fairly. We know what it is like to judge another according to our personal point of view.

What we hold onto can weigh us down. It is not easy to face the fear of forgiveness. How will offering forgiveness make you feel? Sometimes it is hard to let go of that weight. How will accepting forgiveness make you feel? Will this be a turning point where you come to reconcile your differences with your neighbour or friend? Often times it is easier to stay angry with someone than to talk it out and resolve the offense or issues. It is important to remember this; others do not make us angry or upset. We make ourselves angry or upset. No matter what happens to us in this life, we have a choice as to how we react to it. To trust that God is in control of everything that happens to you, can be a tough pill to swallow. To forgive as God forgives us can seem like a monumental task at times.

Do we live in fear of how God will judge us? We should have nothing to fear if we forgive others as God forgives us. There is nothing we can do to make God love us less.

Over the years, as the parent of ten children, I have learned with the help of my kids, there is nothing I can do to make God love me less. Kids will test boundaries and push against many ideals that you hold to be true and even sacred. But, like the tree standing in the middle of the river, it will break when the water moves too rapidly past it. However, the reed in the water will bend without breaking even in the roughest of waters. My kids can do nothing to make me love them less. I did not come to this realization overnight. On the contrary. This probably took many, many years to figure it out and see for myself. I can't put it into words though, that not having to judge my kids, or be angry or resentful towards them, lifted a weight off me that was absolutely freeing. Do they all live their lives as I do? No, and that's okay.

I have learned that it is not my job to judge. This applies to everyone and everything and not just with my family. Yes, it is a relief to have this weight lifted off me. Is it always easy to forgive from the heart? No, but I am a work in progress. You see, I believe, there is nothing I can do to make God love me less.







World Day of Migrants and Refugees—24 September 2023



Free to choose whether to migrate or to stay. In LONDON his message for the 109th World Day of Migrants and Refugees, "Free to choose whether to migrate or to stay", Pope Francis reminds us that the decision to migrate in many cases is not a free choice. It is the result of persecution, wars, atmospheric phenomena and dire poverty, armed conflicts, natural disasters, or the impossibility of living a dignified in one's native land. "Eliminating these causes and thus putting an end to forced migration calls for shared commitment on the part of all, in accordance with the responsibilities of each. This commitment begins with asking what we can do, but also what we need to stop doing. We need to make every effort to halt the arms race, economic colonialism, the plundering of other people's resources and the devastation of our common home." We are all asked to respond to the cry of the poor and the cry of the earth. What are we doing to create a more just and peaceful world for all? "Only by walking together will we be able to go far and reach the common goal of our journey."

Fun Fair and Bake Sale






