



Reflection

Reflection for February 18 and 25, 2024, the First and Second Sundays in Lent.

Have you ever found yourself lost? How about lost in a country that is not your own with road signs that are not in your language? To make matters worse, you do not speak the language of the place you are in. Panic sets in as you realize you are helpless!

This is the First Sunday of Lent. In the scripture for today's Gospel, Jesus has been baptized and "the Spirit drove him out into the wilderness."

Interesting phrase, "the Spirit drove him out." Sounds like Jesus had no say as to where or not he went out into the wilderness. The Spirit that made him go out into the wilderness was very powerful. Perhaps the Spirit dragged Jesus into the wilderness. There was purpose though in going into the wilderness. Saint John Chrysostom tells us, "The Spirit drags Jesus into the desert, since he wanted to draw the devil there; and Jesus gave occasion to him not only on account of his hunger but also on account of the place: for then most especially does the devil attack when he sees people isolated and by themselves."

How true is this! It is times when we are lonely, frightened or isolated, that temptations work their way into our heads. Times of temptation can be experienced in many ways and in many worries of life. We all know that temptations are just part of living a Christian life. The closer we become to God, the more we will be tempted. Satan does NOT like our getting close to God and will do anything to de-rail our attempts at holiness.


Temptation is a very real part of life and is especially challenging in our wilderness times. We are down, discouraged, afraid, disappointed and lonely. Satan loves to kick us when we're down. Every temptation we encounter brings with it a corresponding challenge. Meeting those challenges head on is how we rise above the temptations. Temptations lead us to need God and it is in our time of terrible temptations when we realize that we need God the most.

The good news is that Jesus is with us during our times of wilderness and temptations. God does not leave us alone. The only way to keep from giving up when we find ourselves in the wilderness is to persevere. We must rise to meet the challenges head on and persevere in doing what's right, in being faithful to God, in trusting God, in listening to God, and in loving others as God loves us.

Make this Lent a time to deepen your relationship with God. Spend time seeking God in the scriptures.

In the wilderness Jesus encountered Satan and temptations, Angels and wild beasts. While Mark does not tell us what the temptations were, we know that Jesus overcame them. We do not have to be lost without hope or directions. We all have GPS. No, not the kind that helps us find our way on a map or in a foreign country. We have a God Positioning System. All we need to do is program it to lead us into a deeper connection with God this Lent.

To: The Faithful of the Diocese of London

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

During Lent, we hear the Gospel call to conversion – to turn away from sin and to turn back to God with all our hearts. The gift of God's mercy frees us to serve our sisters and brothers in love. Our own brokenness, the tensions between peoples, and the scourge of hostilities and wars throughout the world make us even more aware of our need for conversion. We all must become instruments of justice and peace. "To the extent that this Lent becomes a time of conversion, an anxious humanity will notice a burst of creativity, a flash of new hope" (Pope Francis, Lenten Message 2024).

To help us in our journey back to God, the Church offers the traditional practices of prayer, fasting and almsgiving. These remedies are meant not only for our own personal healing but to unite and strengthen us with the gifts of the Spirit to build up the Kingdom of God, preparing our hearts to welcome the risen Lord and to welcome one another.

In speaking of injustices in the world, Pope Francis reminds us that "The long journey towards reconciliation and justice, including addressing the structural conditions that abetted such abuse, remains before us, and requires concrete gestures of penitence" (A Synodal Church in Mission, Synthesis Report). This year you to join me, individuals, families, and parish communities, to fast, pray and offer alms for peace – peace in our hearts, peace in our homes, peace in our communities and peace in the world. Let us work together to be peacemakers.

I invite you especially to return to the Eucharist and the Sacrament of Reconciliation. At the Eucharist we gather to behold and receive the Body of Christ, the Prince of Peace. In the Sacrament of Reconciliation, we experience the love, mercy, and healing that only God can offer. This year, our **Annual Day of Confession will be held on Wednesday 20 March**. On that day, churches in the diocese will be open and a priest will be available to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

May we open our hearts this Lenten season to God's merciful love and become instruments of peace. "Peace is primarily a gift of God, for it is He who left us His peace. Yet it is also a responsibility incumbent upon all of us'" (Pope Francis, 8 January 2024).

Romeiros

There is a traditional pilgrimage in Sao Miguel, Azores Island, which dates to the 16th century, to 1522 when a very powerful earthquake and consecutive seismic activities shattered the city of Vila Franca do Campo. The first pilgrims started off after the earthquake to ask for God's protection against further natural disasters and to atone for their own and every other inhabitant's sins.



Ever since, every year for a week during the months of February and March, the male population of Sao Miguel, set off on their pilgrimage around the island in groups of 30 to 200. They visit over 100 churches and chapels on their way, while praying and singing religious songs. Their dress code is strictly defined and so is the role of every individual in the group. They are all wearing a checkered shawl on their backs, a colourful scarf, a rosary around their neck, and holding a special walking cane which they always put down on the ground before entering a church or a chapel.

The pilgrimage takes one week, during which the men are walking from dawn till dusk, with no food, only to retire in the evenings into the houses of local hosts, where they are given a meal and a place to sleep.

To remember and carry on the tradition, there is a group from our family of parishes that walk from All Saints Cemetery to the church on Palm Sunday, March 24th. Chanting the religious prayers and songs, wearing the appropriate attire, the group arrive at the church in time to attend the 11am Mass and gather following the Mass to share a meal together in the church hall.
