

Reflection

Third and Fourth Sundays of Lent, March 3 & 10, 2024

As I was driving to the office this morning in my very dirty van, I found myself following a beautiful white and very clean Lincoln SUV. For a moment, I thought about how nice it would be to own such a beautiful clean and modern vehicle. But then, my common sense kicked in. This was never going to happen to me. For one, I don't need to drive such a vehicle and two, even though I would have a nice new vehicle to drive, it would still be continuously muddy because of where I live. Do appearances really matter?

The opening line from the Second Reading, Paul's letter to the Corinthians, caught my eye as I read over the readings for the next two weeks. "The message about the Cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God." What does this say about appearances?

What do you think about when you look at the Cross? What does it appear to be to you? Do you see it as a symbol of your salvation? Do we see what the Cross represents, or do we see what we want to see?

Many of us wear a sign of our Christianity and or Catholicism around our necks as an outward symbol of our faith. We proclaim Christ crucified! What sign or symbol to others does this give off? If you were questioned about why your wear a cross or crucifix around your neck, would you be able to defend your decision? More importantly, do we take the message that the cross represents to heart.

When I travel to another country, I try to find a cross to bring back home with me. Some of these crosses are hanging in my office on the wall. Each one is unique to the country of origin, reflecting a distinct style of art or colours of the region. I must say the cross I collected in Russia is a bit morbid with skulls and images of the dead under the feet of Jesus.

In the Second Reading for next week, St. Paul tells the Ephesians, "For by grace you have been saved through faith, and this is not our own doing; it is the gift of God." What a beautiful gift of grace this is. How fortunate are we to be saved by the Cross and then given the gift of grace, the gift of faith!

See if you can spend some time this Lent pondering what the Cross means to you. Attending Stations of the Cross is a great way to do this as you are actively part of Jesus journey to the Cross.

It has been said many times that we all need to pick up our cross and carry it through life. This Lent, I challenge you to not only pick up that Cross but to lay yourself down on it and allow yourself to be nailed to it with Jesus. Fully embrace that Cross. Picture yourself at the foot of the Cross with Jesus. Can you bear to look at the suffering he is experiencing? Do you have the courage to offer up all of your suffering to Jesus? God's mercy and unbounding grace awaits us if we but ask! Perhaps part of my cross is to drive around a continuously muddy van.
