#### Entrance Antiphon: Psalm 105:3-4

Let the hearts that seek the Lord rejoice; turn to the Lord and his strength; constantly seek his face.

#### First Reading: Exodus 22:20-26

The faithful and gracious Lord said, "You shall not wrong any widow or orphan...If you take your neighbor's cloak,...return it to him before sunset...If he cries out to me, I will hear him; for I am compassionate."

**Responsorial Psalm:** 18:2-4, 47, 51 I love you, Lord, my strength.

#### **Second Reading: 1 Thessalonians 1:5-10**

Paul commended the Christians of Thessalonica: "You became imitators of us and of the Lord, receiving the word in great affliction, with joy from the Holy Spirit, so that you became a model for all believers...the word of the Lord has sounded forth."

#### Gospel: Matthew 22:34-40

In response to a question from some Pharisees who wanted to trip him up, Jesus said, "You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart...soul...and [mind]...You shall love your neighbor as yourself." These are the two great commandments.



Office Manager Position: Tuesday-Friday, 10:00 am -3:00 pm with additional hours as needed (Up to 25 hours/week). This position includes office responsibilities, bulletin, scheduling, parishioner needs, volunteer recruitment and coordination, coordination with pastor and parish, some bookkeeping duties, and other parish responsibilities.

Lay Pastoral Minister: This part time position is 15-20 hrs./week and involves liturgy collaboration with Fr. Jingbe to include at Sunday and occasionally Saturday masses, holy days and holy seasons; volunteer recruitment and coordination; communication with parishioners; facilitating ongoing religious education for all in the parish; pastoral care, and administration.

The soup kitchen is serving on Saturdays and Sundays only at this time.


