Dear Parishioners.

Annually on the Second Sunday of Advent there is a special evening prayer service and conferral of the Marian Medal by Bishop da Cunha at St. Mary's Cathedral in Fall River on one parishioner nominated from each parish in the diocese. In 1968, then Bishop James Connolly, the 4th Bishop of the Diocese of Fall River, established the tradition of recognizing men and women in the diocese for their dedicated service to the Church. Since then over 2,200 people have been chosen as recipients of the Marian Medal Award. The parishioner must be at least 50 years of age to qualify and have shown particular devotion to the parish. Annually on the Second Sunday of Advent there is a spe-



cial evening prayer service and conferral of the Marian Medal by Bishop da Cunha at St. Mary's Cathedral in Fall River on one parishioner from each parish in the diocese.

It is with great pleasure to share with you that **this year's 2022 Marian Medal recipient from Holy Cross Parish is parishioner Penny Brennan.** Penny and her late husband Kevin joined the Parish in 1969. She taught seventh grade CCD in 1970 and 1971. All four of their children were baptized here. They left for a few years in early 1990's so that the two youngest children could be confirmed at the parish in their Brockton neighborhood. However the family returned to Holy Cross in the mid 1990's. Penny has partici-



pated in the following parish ministries and activities since retirement: Holly Fair, Vacation Bible School, various other volunteer opportunities in the Parish, she has been a Lector since 2015, Faith Formation home school coordinator the past two years, Parish Council member since 2020, is currently serving as a RCIA sponsor, and 8:30am Sunday Mass Greeter. In learning she is this year's recipient, Penny commented: "I am very happy to be a parishioner at Holy Cross and grateful for the opportunity to participate in our Mission to make God known, loved, and served." Congratulations, Penny!

I hope this first week of Advent has challenged you to focus on the Light of Christ increasing not only on the Advent wreath this weekend but also around us in lights inside and out in homes, businesses, and around towns. All of these, whether secular society believes or not, are sign and symbol to us of God in Jesus' presence with us. Please take advantage of the various Advent resources offered to enhance your daily and weekly prayer. Join us this Thursday for the Immaculate Conception holyday Masses at 9am & 7pm. Remember that Giving Tree gifts are due back next weekend as we all look forward to another Holly Fair in-person bringing the joy and happiness of the season here for us. You remain in my thoughts and prayers for a blessed and holy Advent.
