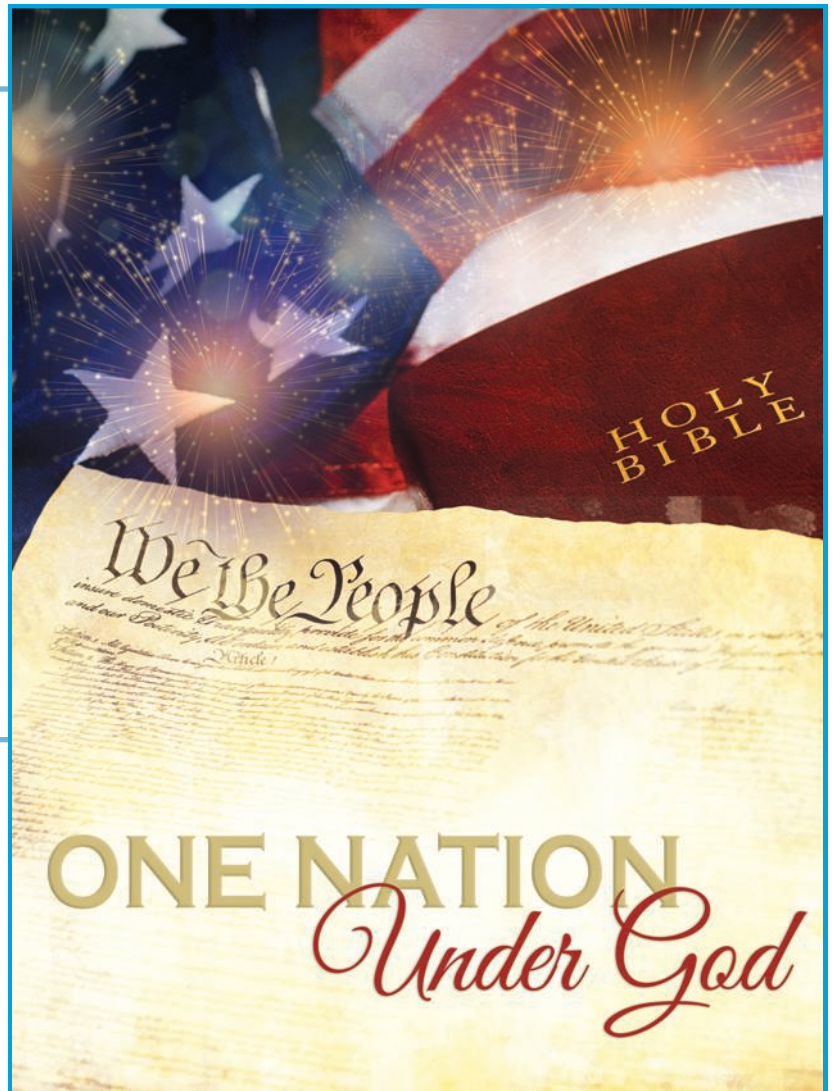

SUNDAY MASS SCHEDULE CHANGE

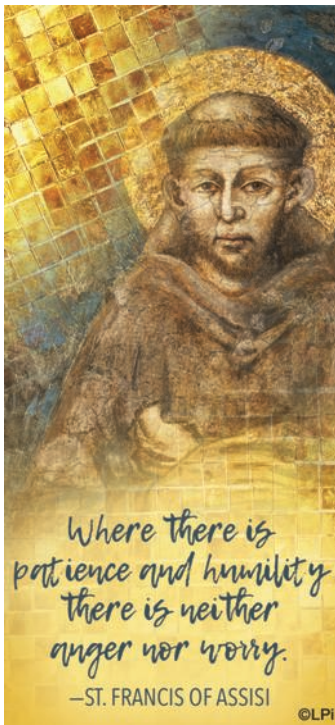
SUNDAY, JULY 4 WILL BE THE FINAL TIME FOR THE 1:30 PM MASS.
