Reading 1: Am 8:4-7

Hear this, you who trample upon the needy and destroy the poor of the land! "When will the new moon be over," you ask, "that we may sell our grain, and the sabbath, that we may display the wheat? We will diminish the ephah, add to the shekel, and fix our scales for cheating! We will buy the lowly for silver, and the poor for a pair of sandals; even the refuse of the wheat we will sell!" The LORD has sworn by the pride of Jacob: Never will I forget a thing they have done!

Reading 2: 1 Tm 2:1-8

Beloved:

First of all, I ask that supplications, prayers, petitions, and thanksgivings be offered for everyone, for kings and for all in authority, that we may lead a quiet and tranquil life in all devotion and dignity.

This is good and pleasing to God our savior, who wills everyone to be saved and to come to knowledge of the truth. For there is one God. There is also one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus, who gave himself as ransom for all. This was the testimony at the proper time.

For this I was appointed preacher and apostle — I am speaking the truth, I am not lying —, teacher of the Gentiles in faith and truth. It is my wish, then, that in every place the men should pray, lifting up holy hands, without anger or argument.

Gospel - Lk 16:1-13

Jesus said to his disciples, "A rich man had a steward who was reported to him for squandering his property.

He summoned him and said, 'What is this I hear about you? Prepare a full account of your stewardship, because you can no longer be my steward.' The steward said to himself, 'What shall I do, now that my master is taking the position of steward away from me?

I am not strong enough to dig and I am ashamed to beg. I know what I shall do so that, when I am removed from the stewardship, they may welcome me into their homes.' He called in his master's debtors one by one. To the first he said, 'How much do you owe my master?'

He replied, 'One hundred measures of olive oil.' He said to him, 'Here is your promissory note. Sit down and quickly write one for fifty.' Then to another the steward said, 'And you, how much do you owe?' He replied, 'One hundred kors of wheat.' The steward said to him, 'Here is your promissory note; write one for eighty.' And the master commended that dishonest steward for acting prudently. "For the children of this world are more prudent in dealing with their own generation than are the children of light. I tell you, make friends for yourselves with dishonest wealth, so that when it fails, you will be welcomed into eternal dwellings. The person who is trustworthy in very small matters is also trustworthy in great ones; and the person who is dishonest in very small matters is also dishonest in great ones. If, therefore, you are not trustworthy with dishonest wealth, who will trust you with true wealth? If you are not trustworthy with what belongs to another, who will give you what is yours? No servant can serve two masters. He will either hate one and love the other, or be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and mammon."

Esto es bueno y agradable a Dios, nuestro salvador, pues él quiere que todos los hombres se salven y todos lleguen al conocimiento de la verdad, porque no hay sino un solo Dios y un solo mediador entre Dios y los hombres, Cristo Jesús, hombre él también, que se entregó como rescate por todos.

Él dio testimonio de esto a su debido tiempo y de esto yo he sido constituido, digo la verdad y no miento, pregonero y apóstol para enseñar la fe y la verdad.

Quiero, pues, que los hombres, libres de odios y divisiones, hagan oración dondequiera que se encuentren, levantando al cielo sus manos puras.

Evangelio: Lc 16, 1-13

En aquel tiempo, Jesús dijo a sus discípulos: "Había una vez un hombre rico que tenía un administrador, el cual fue acusado ante él de haberle malgastado sus bienes. Lo llamó y le dijo: '¿Es cierto lo que me han dicho de tí? Dame cuenta de tu trabajo, porque en adelante ya no serás administrador'. Entonces el administrador se puso a pensar: '¿Que voy a hacer ahora que me quitan el trabajo? No tengo fuerzas para trabajar la tierra y me da vergüenza pedir limosna. Ya sé lo que voy a hacer, para tener a alguien que me reciba en su casa, cuando me despidan'.

Entonces fue llamando uno por uno a los deudores de su amo. Al primero le preguntó: '¿Cuánto le debes a mi amo?' El hombre respondió: 'Cien barriles de aceite'. El administrador le dijo: 'Toma tu recibo, date prisa y haz otro por cincuenta'. Luego preguntó al siguiente: 'Y tú, ¿cuánto debes?' Éste respondió: 'Cien sacos de trigo'. El administrador le dijo: 'Toma tu recibo y haz otro por ochenta'. El amo tuvo que reconocer que su mal administrador había procedido con habilidad. Pues los que pertenecen a este mundo son más hábiles en sus negocios, que los que pertenecen a la luz. Y yo les digo: Con el dinero, tan lleno de injusticias, gánense amigos que, cuando ustedes mueran, los reciban en el cielo. El que es fiel en las cosas pequeñas, también es fiel en las grandes; y el que es infiel en las cosas pequeñas, también es infiel en las grandes. Si ustedes no son fieles administradores del dinero, tan lleno de injusticias, ¿quién les confiará los bienes verdaderos? Y si no han sido fieles en lo que no es de ustedes, ¿quién les confiará lo que sí es de ustedes? No hay criado que pueda servir a dos amos, pues odiará a uno y amará al otro, o se apegará al primero y despreciará al segundo. En resumen, no pueden ustedes servir a Dios y al dinero".

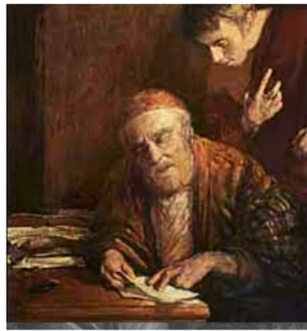

in Ordinary Time**

When we grasp a better understanding of Amos, it really is a mirror of the Gospel message that we must be good stewards and offer kindness and justice to all. Remember that Jesus is in the midst of speaking through a series of parables. (We left off with the Prodigal Son last week.) When he is speaking of the steward, he is not telling us to get into money laundering or get-rich-quick schemes or engage in multi-level marketing. Rather, we can infer that we are to use our goods and our skills wisely and for the betterment of everyone. In the parable the steward is praised for his quick thinking and for finding a way to resolve the situation. The parable ends with Jesus telling us "You cannot serve God and mammon" and you must make a choice.

EVERYTHING IS A CHOICE

The Gospel parable tells us what the steward did one time to get out of a bind. But we are called to make the right choice, the best choice over and over. Sometimes it is hard. You may not be choosing between good and evil, but sometimes even have to choose between two goods. We frequently have to make choices like, "Do I spend this extra time at work to get that promotion? Do I bring the work home with me? Or am I able to leave it there and be with my family when I am done?" Parents often have to look at their savings account before they determine which activities they can afford for their children to participate in. Music and sports and the arts are wonderful, but all require special equipment and time. But making a sacrifice on everybody's part might reap great rewards. Sometimes, though, the choice is made to just get food on the table, or to clothe the family. We learn to make the choices that are best for ourselves and are decisions we can live with. We learn to discern what is best for those we love.

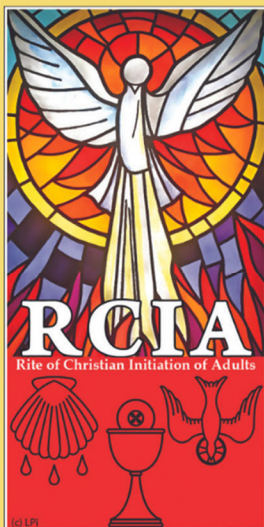
Cuando comprendemos mejor a Amós, es realmente un espejo del mensaje evangélico de que debemos ser buenos administradores y ofrecer bondad y justicia a todos. Recuerda que Jesús está hablando a través de una serie de parábolas. (La semana pasada se proclamó la parábola del hijo pródigo). Cuando habla del mayordomo, no nos dice que nos dediquemos a blanquear dinero o a hacernos ricos rápidamente, ni que nos dediquemos al marketing multinivel. Más bien, podemos deducir que debemos utilizar nuestros bienes y nuestras habilidades con sabiduría y para el mejoramiento de todos. En la parábola, el mayordomo es alabado por su rapidez de pensamiento y por encontrar una manera de resolver la situación. La parábola termina con Jesús diciéndonos "No pueden servir a Dios y a las riquezas" y deben de hacer una elección.

TODOS ES UNA ELECCIÓN

La parábola del Evangelio nos cuenta lo que el mayordomo hizo una vez para salir de un apuro. Pero estamos llamados a hacer la elección correcta, la mejor elección una y otra vez. A veces es difícil. Puede que no haya que elegir entre el bien y el mal, pero a veces incluso hay que elegir entre dos bienes. A menudo tenemos que tomar decisiones como: "¿Paso este tiempo extra en el trabajo para conseguir ese ascenso? ¿Me llevo el trabajo a casa? ¿O puedo dejarlo allí y estar con mi familia cuando termine?". Los padres a menudo tienen que mirar su cuenta de ahorros antes de determinar qué actividades pueden permitirse para que sus hijos participen. La música y los deportes y las artes son maravillosos, pero todos requieren un equipo especial y tiempo. Pero hacer un sacrificio por parte de todos puede reportar grandes recompensas. Sin embargo, a veces hay que elegir para llevar la comida a la mesa o para vestir a la familia. Aprendemos a tomar las decisiones que son mejores para nosotros y con las que podemos vivir. Aprendemos a discernir qué es lo mejor para los que amamos.

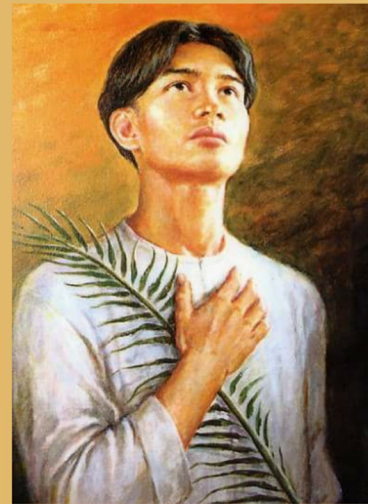

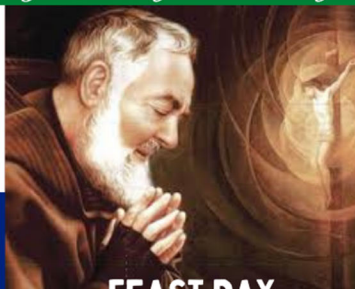
Did You Know?

Babies under the age of one are at a risk of choking but handling a blocked airway in such a young child requires a different approach. If the baby cannot cough, cry, or breathe, support him "face down" by holding the head in one hand with the torso on your forearm, against your thigh. Give up to five back thumps between the shoulder blades with the heel of your other hand. If this does not work, roll the infant face up and provide five chest thrusts, about 1 ½ inches deep, with two fingers on the breastbone, just below the nipple line. Cómo responder a la asfixia, segunda parte

Los bebés menores de un año corren el riesgo de asfixiarse, pero el manejo de una vía respiratoria bloqueada en un niño tan pequeño requiere abordarlo en una forma distinta. Si el bebé no puede toser, llorar o respirar, sosténgalo "boca abajo" tomando su cabeza con una mano con el torso sobre su antebrazo, contra su muslo. Dé hasta cinco golpes en la espalda entre los omóplatos con la base de la otra mano. Si esto no funciona, ponga al bebé boca arriba y dele cinco compresiones en el pecho, de aproximadamente 1 pulgada y media de profundidad, con dos dedos en el esternón, justo debajo de la línea de los pezones. St. Padre Pio Powerful Healing

Prayer Heavenly Father, I thank you for loving me. I thank you for sending your Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, to the world to save and to set me free. 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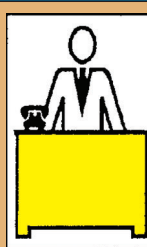

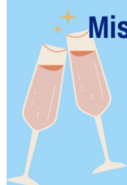
