Knitting and Prayer Group Seeks Yarn Donations

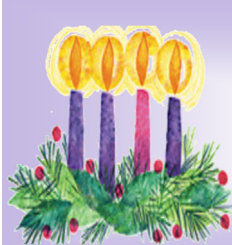

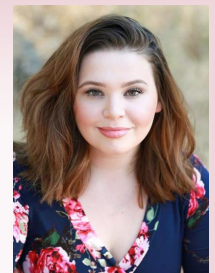
