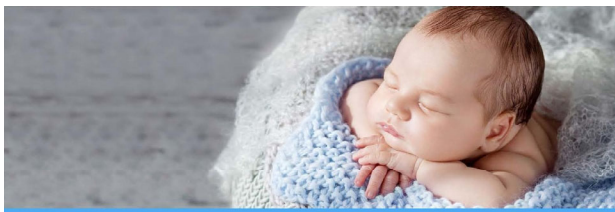

For those of you who attend 9:30am Mass, you will see a drastic reduction of those who are dismissed after the homily. Several of our candidates and catechumens are moving into the Period of Purification and Enlightenment. Be sure to look at their pictures and take a bookmark/prayer card for home and pray for them throughout Lent. Lent is their final preparation period before they receive their Sacraments at the Easter Vigil Mass.

This same group will still be dismissed after the homily, but they will be at different Masses. On February 29 at the 8:30am Mass, they will be dismissed with a Rite of Sending. From there they will be presented to the Bishop. (*Details of this and all of the Rites are available on the RCIA display table in the narthex with all of their pictures*). On March 7 at the 5:00pm Mass, there will be a Penitential Rite for the candidates. March 15 at 11:30am Mass will be their first Scrutiny, March 22 at 7:30am Mass is their second Scrutiny and March 29 at the 5:00pm Mass is their third and final Scrutiny. We celebrate these Rites at the various Masses so that you can see who you are praying for.
