#### Dear St. Clare Parishioners,

Upon the advice of health officers from local counties to stem contagion of COVID-19, and in compliance with the Bishop's directives, our parish leadership will err on the side of caution by limiting events on campus to liturgies and small prayer events through March 31. St. Clare Parish is implementing the following measures immediately:

- The baptismal font will be emptied
- The procedures for liturgy that have been implemented will continue
- The dispensation for persons who 60+ years old or who have chronic medical issues will remain active (see the attached memo and decree from the diocese)
