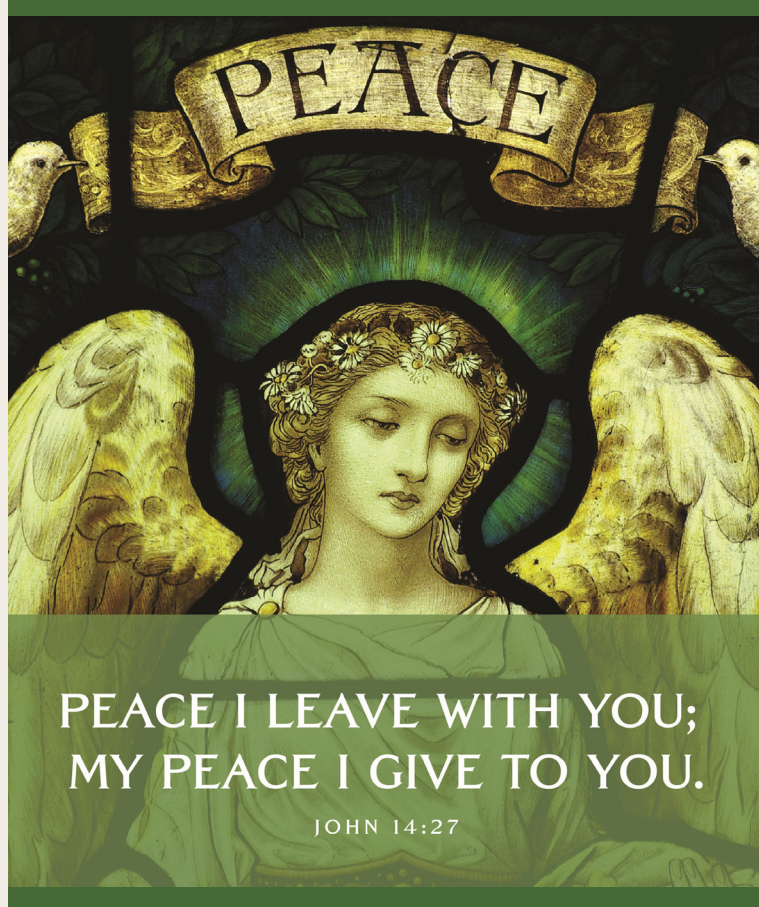

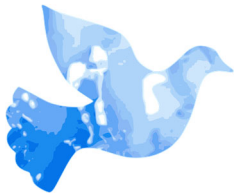

St. Clare Baptism Preparation Program

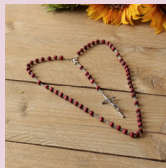

Baptisms: The Baptism Request form is available in the Narthex, at the parish office, and on our parish website under "Sacraments." Preparation for baptism may begin before birth of the child.

Weddings: Fill out the request forms on our website under the "Forms" menu and return to the Parish Office. A coordinator will contact you. *Six months notice is required for weddings.*

Anointing of the Sick: Call the Parish Office to arrange anointing. Use the emergency prompts after office hours if death is imminent.

Receive the Blessed Sacrament (at home or hospital): Call the Parish Office to arrange for a Homebound Minister.

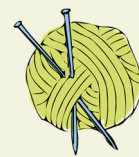

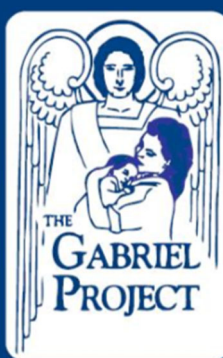
