Lenten Regulations and Admonitions

Lent is a 40 day season of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving that begins on Ash Wednesday.

Fasting - all faithful between ages 18 and 59 are bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

Abstinence - All faithful 14 and older are required to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays in Lent.

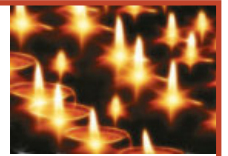

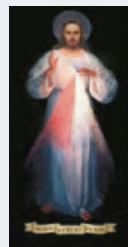

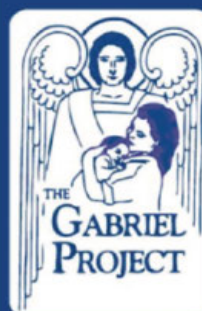
