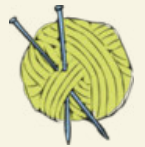


Grief, Consolation, and Hope Ministry

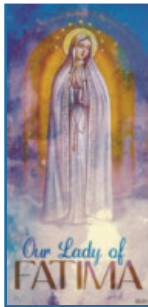
