


Sacraments at St. Clare

Baptisms: The Baptism Request form is available at the parish office and on our parish website under "Sacraments." Preparation for baptism may begin before birth of the child.

Weddings: Fill out the request forms on our website under the "Forms" menu and return to the Parish Office. A coordinator will contact you. *Six months notice is required for weddings.*

Anointing of the Sick: Call the Parish Office at (916) 772-4717 to arrange anointing. Use the emergency prompts after office hours if death is imminent.

Receive the Blessed Sacrament (at home or hospital): Call the Parish Office to arrange for a Homebound Minister.
