Students with developmental and/or intellectual disAbilities and their families are invited to be part of St. Clare's individualized Adaptive Faith Formation program. Candidates will focus on preparing to receive their sacraments, working on the skills necessary to attend Mass, and participate in parish life events.

We have a team of dedicated St. Clare catechists who work with children, youth, and families according to their gifts. This includes an initial interview meeting with the lead catechist to assess best placement for the child or youth based on strengths and needs.

Our class cycle starts October 1 with an open registration. There is no cost. Registration forms are available in both the Parish Office and the Faith Formation Office. 
