MOMS Ministry Bible Study

St. Clare MOMS Ministry is hosting a fall Bible Study, "Reclaiming Friendship." All interested women are invited to participate in this 7-week Bible study, starting September 12 through October 24th from 6:30-8:30pm at St. Clare (rooms will vary). This is another study from "Walking with Purpose" (please check out their website at www.walkingwithpurpose.com).

Here is an excerpt from the website describing this study:

"Reclaiming Friendship: 'God's Plan for Deep Connection' was written for any woman who wants a true and deep connection that lasts. Explore what it takes to stay close for the long haul, what to look for in a friend, and how to navigate toxic relationships. There is a way to protect your heart without closing yourself off from future intimacy. The key is found in discovering God's plan for friendship, which was meant to be a foretaste of heaven."

The format will be small groups led by facilitators with prayer, a video, and sharing. There is "homework" for this study as well. The deadline to register is August 29, and the cost is \$35 to cover the workbook and other materials. Registration forms are available in the parish office.
