

Social Concerns

The Social Concerns Ministry started the High School Support Program last April to help Victory High School (VHS), an alternative high school in Rocklin. Our program is designed to help teens at alternative high schools in and around our area. We currently support VHS and hope to add Adelante High School in Roseville by January 2024. At VHS, approximately 70 of the 110 students do not get dinner at home and the only meals they do get are breakfast and lunch which are provided by the school. The weekend meal bags we supply once a month provide 12 meals and are available to all students while supplies last throughout the month. 12 meals x 50 bags = 600 meals per month.

With coordination from St. Vincent DePaul, Placer Food Bank, food drives from local high schools, and your help, we hope to provide VHS students with over 6,000 meals during the 2023-2024 school year!!

Our program is designed to offer support to teenagers aged 16-18 with not only the meals but also with blankets, sleeping bags, school backpacks and supplies, hygiene kits, clothing, shoes, socks, and other items as needed. The biggest families in need will also be included in the Thanksgiving and Christmas programs.

We feel that by showing these students that someone cares is the best way to show how important each of them are to their schools and communities. We will be collecting **high protein shakes** and **high protein energy bars** through the month of September.

St. Clare MOMS Ministry is hosting a fall Bible Study, "Reclaiming Friendship." All interested women are invited to participate in this 7-week Bible study, starting September 12 through October 24th from 6:30-8:30pm at St. Clare (rooms will vary). This is another study from "Walking with Purpose" (please check out their website at www.walkingwithpurpose.com).

Here is an excerpt from the website describing this study:
