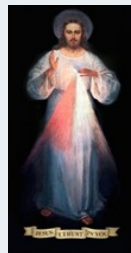

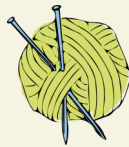
- **The Growing up Catholic Mass Transit Cards:**

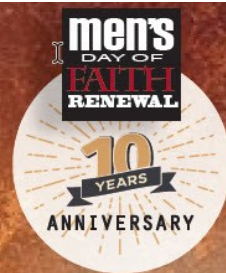

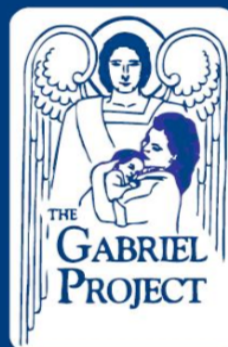
