

Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception

First Sunday of Advent

The first candle on the Advent wreath represents Hope. The first Sunday of

Advent not only leads us to anticipate the birth of Christ but also to celebrate the beginning of a new liturgical season. It is purple, the primary color of Advent and a color symbolizing royalty. Sometimes called the "Prophecy Candle," the first candle harkens us back to Isaiah's fortelling of the birth of Christ and all of the promises God gave us in the Old Testament that would be fulfilled by the birth of Jesus.


Social Concerns



Advent Wreath Blessing Prayer


