


Come and join our Bible Study Group starting January 10, 2024. This is a very friendly study with great commentaries on the scriptures, sharing of your insights with others in the group.

The Stone of St. Michael the Archangel from the Shrine of St. Michael in Gargano, Italy

High atop a mountainous promontory called Monte Gargano in Southeastern Italy, is the oldest shrine dedicated to St. Michael in western Europe. According to tradition, St. Michael the Archangel appeared to an Italian bishop in 493 and consecrated a nearby cave. This became known as the Sanctuary of Monte Sant'Angelo sul Gargano, more commonly referred to as Monte Gargano.

Over a thousand years later, tradition claims St. Michael appeared again at the shrine, where he told the bishop, "I am the Archangel St. Michael. Anyone who uses the stones of this grotto will be liberated." Since then, tiny stones from this grotto have been distributed around the world and are known as "St. Michael Stones." These are popular sacramentals that are used by the faithful to invoke the intercession of this powerful intercessor to protect them and grant them God's graces.

If you are interested in acquiring your own St. Michael Stone reliquary, you can stop by the parish office. The \$60 donation covers the cost of the 24-carat gold-plated reliquary that holds the stone (not the stone itself, which is included), the certificate, and shipping. Proceeds support the Shrine of St Michael in Gargano.






Epiphany Blessing of the Door

The Blessing of the Doors has roots in Polish and German customs. It recalls the visit of the Magi, strangers in a foreign land, and how they were welcomed by Mary and Joseph at the stable in Bethlehem. The blessing reminds us of the welcome that we owe to all who visit us, regarding them as nothing less than Christ himself.

Directions: At home, members of the family gather outside the main door of the house. The head of the household leads the prayer of blessing after which he/she writes the following inscription (in chalk) on the head jamb:



Blessed chalk is available in the narthex, or you may use your blessed chalk from a previous year. The letters C, M, and B are the initials of the Three Magi. They are also attributed to the Latin phrase "Christus mansionem benedicat" which in English means "May Christ bless this dwelling place."

Blessing Prayer

Lord God of heaven and earth, You revealed Your only-begotten Son to every nation by the guidance of a star. Fill us with the light of Christ, that our concern for others may reflect Your love. Bless this house, all who inhabit it, and all who pass through these doors. May this home and this family be a light for all who are lost and afraid, a place of peace and hospitality for those in need, and a sign that You are indeed God-with-us. And when our long journey has ended, lead us all by the star of Your mercy, that we may come home to You to the dwelling place You have prepared for us in heaven. Grant this through Christ our Lord. Amen.
