

Anointing of the Sick and Blessing of Medical Professionals and Caregivers

February 10 & 11

On February 10-11, after the Saturday 8:30am Mass and all other weekend Masses, we will celebrate the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes and the World Day of the Sick by offering the Anointing of the Sick to parishioners who meet the criteria for Anointing (see below). Our clergy will also



confer a blessing on medical professionals and caregivers who care for the sick.

Who may receive the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick? Any baptized Catholic who:

- is dangerously ill through sickness or old age
- is sick or facing surgery
- is elderly and suffering weakness, though not necessarily dangerously ill
- is a sick child (at least aged 7) and sufficiently mature to be comforted by the sacrament
- has not already received the sacrament for the same illness if their condition remains the same

We welcome anyone who meets the criteria to come receive the Anointing of the Sick after all Masses the weekend of February 10-11.


