




Snack Angels Ministry



The Feast of St. Thomas the Apostle is a liturgical celebration that honors St. Thomas, one of the twelve apostles of Jesus Christ. He is perhaps best known for initially doubting the

resurrection of Jesus until he could see and touch the wounds of the risen Christ—hence his common nickname, "Doubting Thomas."

According to tradition, after Pentecost, Thomas traveled to India to spread the Gospel. He is considered the founder of the Christian community there.

The feast celebrates not only the St. Thomas' eventual deep faith but also serves as a reminder that doubt, when pursued sincerely, can lead to profound belief.
