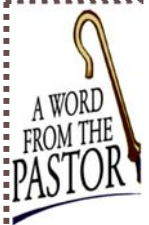

Dear Friends In Christ,

**THE LORD IS MY SHEPHERD THERE IS NOTHING I SHALL WANT.**

Psalm 23 is one of the best known passages in Sacred Scripture, precious to Christians and Jews alike. One time I was visiting a sick child in a children's hospital and there was a Jewish family nearby who asked me to come into the room and pray with them. This presented me with the proverbial "we didn't cover this pastoral situation in our seminary training" moment. The reality is that we did and by the grace of God and by my still developing pastoral instincts, I immediately thought of Psalm 23 and easily found it in the Book of Blessings I was carrying with me.

This was a moment of being at once a shepherd, and one of the sheep. I was called to be the one leading and guiding, and yet, I needed to be led and guided. During this time of pandemic, it seems that this is where we all are. We are saying and doing things we never would have imagined at the beginning of this year. We are in need of being shepherded and we are being called to shepherd others. We are now, perhaps more than ever, aware of our dependence upon our loving God. Why not learn to be more grateful to Him!

In the *Spiritual Exercises*, Saint Ignatius of Loyola writes about the importance of gratitude as a principal for our relationship with God. Here are four things to remember as you gather with your families for Thanksgiving Day this Thursday:

- Everything is gift.
- God dwells intimately in all God's gifts.
- God's love is actively at work on our behalf.
- God is the loving source, from whom all blessings flow.

May you and your families be blessed and protected by our God as you celebrate this wonderful holiday. Have a great week!

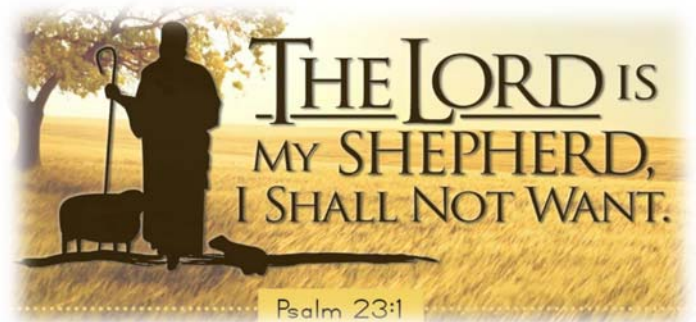
