FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Friends In Christ,

This Wednesday, March 2nd, is Ash Wednesday. Please see the schedule of Masses and services for the day in this bulletin. You will also see information regarding an opportunity for Lenten Faith Sharing and Lenten Bible Study. On the Wednesdays of Lent, we will have Stations of the Cross at 6:30pm, with the exception of March 23rd due to Confirmation Practice and April 13th due to Parish Confessions.

The traditional practices for Lent are: **prayer, fasting and almsgiving**. Please take some time and think about how you would like to increase your prayer in order to spend more time with God; fast so as to turn away from sin; and, give alms, to follow the example of Christ to love others. Fasting can often be the one practice that we don't emphasize because we may not fully understand why we are doing it. Keeping in mind that fasting is not merely fasting from food, that is, we can fast from other things that bring us pleasure such watching television, being on our computers, gaming, shopping, etc., Here are 7 reasons our Christian tradition offers us for fasting:

1. From the beginning, God commanded some fasting, and sin entered into the world because Adam and Eve broke the fast.
2. For the Christian, fasting is ultimately about fasting from sin.
3. Fasting reveals our dependence on God and not the resources of this world.
4. Fasting is an ancient way of preparing for the Eucharist - the truest of foods.
5. Fasting is preparation for baptism (and all the sacraments - for the reception of grace.
6. Fasting is a means of saving resources to give to the poor.
7. Fasting is a means of self-discipline, chastity, and the restraining of the appetites.
